IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1) Parent Respect in Sport Program

In an ongoing effort to foster a safe and enjoyable environment for our athletes in this great game, Vancouver Island Amateur Hockey Association (VIAHA) has implemented the Respect in Sport (RIS) program.

At least one parent or guardian of each player registered in minor hockey on Vancouver Island must complete the online RIS Parent Program **prior** to registration. <u>The link to the RIS Parent Program is here!</u>

2) AUGUST 1st FEE INCREASE!

We are encouraging all players to register early! It helps CRMHA with ice planning, coach planning and being organized going into the season. <u>Early</u> <u>Bird Registration is until July 31st only!</u>

3) VOLUNTEER REGISTRATION is REQUIRED!

There is a separate link to register as a volunteer. If you would like to volunteer as a Coach, Manager and/or Safety People please ensure you have registered. You will have access to see your own profile, what qualifications you have and/or need. (Note the Criminal Record Check status can be found under the History tab, not Qualifications). Please review the required courses for the volunteer position you are interested in! The information and links to the courses is on our website under the Volunteer Tab.

A Criminal Record Check is free, and required before you are on the ice! Respect in Sport Leader, is also required before you volunteer. This course is refundable on completion. *Note, this is NOT the same as the Respect in Sport Parent version, which as noted above is mandatory for every player. The RIS Leader version is no longer considered a replacement.

REGISTRATION FOR PLAYERS
