IMPORTANT AND NEW FOR THE 2023 SEASON!

1) Parent Respect in Sport Program

VIAHA has changed the requirements for the Parent Respect in Sport Program!

As of March 31st, 2023 the 'Team Official/Coach' Version of Respect in Sport will no longer be accepted as a replacement to the requirements originally implemented in 2015 for one Parent to complete the Respect in Sport course prior to player registration.

Any parents that have already taken the Parent Version of RIS previously in hockey or with any other group (and have successfully credited their child's Hockey Canada Registry Profile) will not need to do anything to meet this requirement.

However, all players registering for the 2023-2024 season will need to be credited with the Parent Version. The Parent Version is significantly different to the Volunteer Version and provides specific information valuable to sports parents. If currently one or both parents/guardians have competed the Respect in Sport for Activity Leader, **one parent/guardian is required to compete the Respect in Sport for Parent.**

2) AUGUST 1st FEE INCREASE!

We are encouraging all players to register early! It helps CRMHA with ice planning, coach planning and being organized going into the season. In years past we have offered an Early Bird \$50 discount to your fees if you registered before August 1st which will continue! However, this season there will be an additional fee of \$50.00 if you register after August 1st!

3) VOLUNTEER REGISTRATION is REQUIRED!

There is a separate link to register as a volunteer for this year. If you would like to volunteer as a Coach, Manager and/or Safety People please ensure you have registered. You will have access to see your own profile, what qualifications you have and/or need. (Note the Criminal Record Check status can be found under the History tab, not Qualifications). Please review the required courses for the volunteer position you are interested in! The information on what is needed, and links to the courses is on our website under the Volunteer Tab.

A Criminal Record Check is free, and required before you are on the ice! Respect in Sport – Leader, is also required before you volunteer. This course is refundable on completion. *Note, this is NOT the same as the Respect in Sport Parent version, which as noted above is mandatory for every player. The RIS Leader version is no longer considered a replacement.
