



Female Player Registration Information



Welcome to CRMHA! We are looking forward to a fantastic season! Please review the below information on steps to register, information about equipment, and all things about our Female Hurricane Hockey Program! Our Hockey season starts after the September long weekend and ends in the middle of March! if you have any problems registering, or questions, please email Tamara at info@crmha.ca

Female Players have 3 options for registration including the option to choose JUST the Female Development program should you wish.

- 1) **HOUSE ONLY** - You can register simply for co-ed recreation hockey, choosing the registration package "RECREATION CO-ED LEAGUE"
*this does not include any Female Development ice. (Typically, 2-3 ice times/week including one early morning ice per/week)
- 2) **FEMALE ONLY** - You can register for Female Development only, meaning you will not play recreation hockey and will play on Female Development ice only. For this option choose the package "FEMALE ONLY PROGRAM" (Typically 1-2 ice times/week *possible one early morning ice time/week)

Typical Practices for Female Hurricanes / Development:

U7/9 Female Hurricanes - Wednesday 5:15-6:15 PM

U13 Female Hurricanes - Wednesday 6:30-7:30 PM

U11/185 Female Hurricanes - Wednesday 7:45-8:45 PM

Should there be enough registered females to form Hurricane teams in divisions U11 and up, they will play in the Female Island League which is typically is 12 games. 6 of those games are at home (here in Campbell River) and the other six could be in:

- Port McNeil
- Parksville
- Nanaimo
- Duncan
- Victoria

- 3) **BOTH** - You can register for both Recreation hockey, and Female Development, and would choose the registration package "RECREATION CO-ED LEAGUE PLUS FEMALE DEV" (Typically, 3-5 ice times/week, including early mornings. Ice time conflicts - Female game takes priority over co-ed ice time)

Mini Hockey School

We have a Mini Hockey school if you want to get a jumpstart and onto the ice before the season starts! This is additional ice and includes 4 sessions August 29th to September 1st and costs \$80. During the registration process, you will be able to add this under “optional items”

The initial registration payment must be made at the time of registration. However should you need assistance with your hockey fees, there are a number of excellent grant programs to assist with registration costs and we encourage application to any of them. HOW TO REGISTER with CRMHA:

If you have never participated in organized hockey as a player, coach, and/or volunteer (including the NHL First Shift Program), then you do not exist in the Hockey Canada Registry. If your child has played anywhere in Hockey Canada or registered for ANY MHA in the past, DO NOT create a new profile. This will result in a duplicate player profile and will render your child ineligible during the season. Please refer to the registration information under “TRANSFER from another association”

Step 1:

In an ongoing effort to foster a safe and enjoyable environment for our athletes in this great game, Vancouver Island Amateur Hockey Association (VIAHA) has implemented the Respect in Sport (RIS) program.

At least one parent or guardian of each player registered in minor hockey on Vancouver Island must complete the online RIS Parent Program **prior** to registration. [The link to the RIS Parent Program is here!](#)

Once you have completed the RIS Parent Program requirements, Hockey Canada will create a profile for your child, including a Hockey Canada ID number, which will then allow you to register with CRMHA. You must complete the course before proceeding to Step 2.

STEP 2:

Once at the registration page choose “Don’t have an account? Sign Up” This is your sign in information only, and the account should be under the parent/guardian name.

Before registering, ensure you have read the Codes of Conducts, (including the Dressing Room and Bullying Policies) in the Policy and Procedures found [here](#)

STEP 3:

Choose: Register an existing participant. Then click **Start Registration**

- 1) Search and Select the participant(s) you wish to register
- 2) Choose which registration package you want
- 3) Answer the CRMHA questionnaire
- 4) Add Optional Items Mini Hockey School to your registration **if you wish**
- 5) REVIEW and accept the waivers – REVIEW the P&P manual available on our website, and the various codes of conduct with your player. They must be aware of expectations.
- 6) Register another participant OR Next
- 7) Choose **pay in full** or **pay in installments (if available)**
- 8) Agree to payment terms and conditions – choose next
- 9) Complete payment and submit!
- 10) You will receive an invoice indicating that you are complete.

The initial payment must be made at the time of registration and includes the mandatory BC Hockey Fee plus 25% of your total cost of registration.
