Welcome to CRMHA! We are looking forward to a fantastic season!

New players have 2 choices for registration – one being directly with CRMHA the other is with the NHL First Shift Program.

The **CRMHA Hockey** season starts after the September long weekend and ends in the middle of March. Registration fees and information are below!

The other option for new players is the **NHL First Shift Program**. The NHL First Shift Program takes away any intimidation as it relates to equipment requirements, and/or rules of the game, remove potential safety concerns, and most importantly, provide an experience that is memorable and fun. It also includes ALL of your equipment! This Program however, does **not** start until February 2023 and ends in April.

NHL FIRST SHIFT PARTICIPANT REGISTRATION FEE OF \$229 INCLUDES:

The NHL/NHLPA First Shift is open to children, between the ages of 6 and 10 years old*, who have never previously enrolled in minor hockey within Canada or the NHL/NHLPA First Shift program.

**To be eligible to participate, children must be born between January 1, 2012 and May 1, 2017.*

HOW TO REGISTER with CRMHA:

If you have never participated in organized hockey as a player, coach, and/or volunteer (including the NHL First Shift Program), then you do not exist in the Hockey Canada Registry. If your child has played anywhere in Hockey Canada or registered for ANY MHA in the past, DO NOT create a new profile. This will result in a duplicate player profile and will render your child ineligible during the season.

Step 1:

In an ongoing effort to foster a safe and enjoyable environment for our athletes in this great game, Vancouver Island Amateur Hockey Association (VIAHA) has implemented the Respect in Sport (RIS) program.

At least one parent or guardian of each player registered in minor hockey on Vancouver Island must complete the online RIS Parent Program **prior** to registration. [The link to the RIS Parent Program is here!](#)

Once you have completed the RIS Parent Program requirements, Hockey Canada will create a profile for your child, including a Hockey Canada ID number, which will then allow you to register with CRMHA. You must complete the course before proceeding to Step 2.

STEP 2:

Before registering, ensure you have read the Codes of Conducts, (including the Dressing Room and Bullying Policies) in the Policy and Procedures found [here](#)

Please proceed to the online registration platform and choose the “Don’t have an account? Sign Up” This is your sign in information only, and the account should be under the parent/guardian name.

STEP 3:

Choose: Register an existing participant. Then click **Start Registration**

- 1) Search and Select the participant(s) you wish to register
- 2) Choose which registration package you want
- 3) Answer the CRMHA questionnaire
- 4) Add Optional Items Mini Hockey School to your registration **if you wish**
- 5) REVIEW and accept the waivers – REVIEW the P&P manual available on our website, and the various codes of conduct with your player. They must be aware of expectations.
- 6) Register another participant OR Next

- 7) Choose **pay in full** or **pay in installments (if available)**
- 8) Agree to payment terms and conditions – choose next
- 9) Complete payment and submit!
- 10) You will receive an invoice indicating that you are complete.

The initial payment must be made at the time of registration and includes the mandatory BC Hockey Fee plus 25% of your total cost of registration.
