 - Attended the Atom Pathway and Officiating workshops
 - Officiating workshop
 - There will be a survey going out to officials.
 - They presented the top reasons officials do not return. First on the list was conflict with other activities. Official abuse was not high on the list.
 - Campbell River rates higher than the provincial average at retaining officials.
 - The Cowichan Ref camp is going to offer more interactive instruction time, to make it more fun.
 - Instituting a grad (bursary) program for refs aging out and financial support to get more training for higher level hockey.
