Submitted • We have already almost hit our budgeted revenues for the year thanks to registrations and rep and development fees exceeding budget by over \$25K combined.

- We have exceeded budget in the following expenses:
 - Power skating clinics (\$3.5K actual vs. \$2.4K budgeted)
 - We still have lots of funds left for development clinics (\$13K remaining)
 - o Because of the U9 jerseys (\$5K) we are essentially over budget that amount for equipment
 - We are \$7K overbudget for tournaments (away) due to having more teams.
 - Referee expenses are higher in proportion to ice fees than we budgeted....it's a bit early to say but we may be over budget here by the end of the year.

- Of note, gaming revenue is very difficult to reconcile due to it coming in from multiple places, attaching itself for 3 bank accounts, deposits made by the online square account that are random and don't indicate what they are for, etransfers being sent before the money is in the bank etc. I have spent HOURS figuring it out and how to make it work going forward.
- We have had a couple very success 50/50 draws. Gaming revenue have specific rules around spending allocation (ie, used to benefit the association as a whole). Comparisons of home tournament fundraising from last year.
