- Currently have 2 of our officials at the Lake Cowichan officials camp (July 25-29th); Verly and Lihou.
- Going through the registration reports, and collecting contact information for who has indicated an interest in officiating.
- Had a meeting with BCHockey. Last year they said that any official who refereed in a non-sanctioned league (NSL) could not officiate in minor hockey. This year, that has changed, officials can ref both in a NSL and as a minor hockey as well.
- BC hockey is piloting super-clinics for recertification. Instead of each hockey association having their own clinics, there would be one in Nanaimo for mid to north island, and 2 in the south island. Jacqui can host a north island clinic (here) if necessary.
