7.1 League Updates

- J. Bassett informed the membership that Camrose Minor Hockey has been accepted as a full member with Central Alberta Hockey League. Overall it was felt that it was a good fit and travel was reduced for many teams.
- We will look at placing our teams in a lower tier at the beginning of the season as in some instances they were placed too high initially.
- We are researching alternatives for the female teams as Rocky Mountain Female Hockey League has not improved on the issues from the previous seasons i.e. scheduling, travel. Board felt that the Edmonton league would not be a good fit as they have reduced game times with U11 only have 1 hour long games. The schedule only gets released month to month. Will look at the ECHL but concerned that they only have "B" teams and our teams were all classified as "A" teams.
- Review of the new policy re: U11 Underage policy that will be implemented for the 2023 – 2024 season will be posted to the website following the May 15 regular board meeting.

7.2 Hockey Alberta Announcement re: Name for U15 to U18 Non Hit teams

 Hockey Alberta released a statement this afternoon that all Non Hit teams from Tier 4 to 6 will be renamed as follows:

Tier 4 = Tier 1 Non Body Checking (NBC)

Tier 5 = Tier 2 NBC Tier 6 = Tier 3 NBC

8.0 Questions / Concerns from the floor:

 Concerns regarding the Female League were reiterated and that we should continue to look at the Edmonton League.

- Concern regarding U9 and if we could have a hybrid system of teams that did not want
 to travel separate from those that did. Concern with this is that if we only have 2 teams
 that did not play in the league, they would have no one to play against. We will voice
 our concerns with CAHL that travel must stick to the 150 km.
- Will Interleague games continue? Following discussions at a CAHL meeting, it was
 determined that this did not work out well and if CAHL is going to continue with this,
 they will have to do a better job of it.
