GAME CONSIDERATIONS CHECKLIST

HOST ASSOCIATION:

The following considerations provide a checklist for a host team/ association to communicate relevant information to the teams, spectators, and timekeepers prior to any games. It is important that the host communicates with its facility so that any specific guidelines/ regulations in place for that facility are shared with visiting team(s).

TEAMS:

MASKING REQUIREMENTS

o **Within the municipality:** Masks are now mandatory when in any indoor Public area in the community of Camrose

o **Within the facility:** Mask are mandatory as soon as you enter the building and must remain on until you take it off to put on your helmet to enter the ice surface and again the mask must be put back on when re-entering the room.

In the room, you can remove the mask to take a drink of water, but then the mask must be put back on.

When using the showers, the mask can be removed. (as of Nov 5, 2020 – City of Camrose Bylaw)

ENTRY AND EXIT PROCESS

o **Time restrictions:** Player, Coaches and officials can enter the facility and their dressing room <u>30</u> minutes prior their game and must vacate the facility within <u>30 minutes of the end</u> of the game.

o **Specific doors:** All Entrance doors are located on the East and North side of our facility and clearly marked. Hand Sanitizer stations are available adjacent to each access door and throughout the facility and are to be applied upon entry.

DRESSING ROOM ACCESS

o Participant maximums: Max 50 persons per event.

o **Time restrictions prior to or after games:** Player, Coaches and officials are allowed to enter the facility and their dressing room 30 minutes prior their game and must vacate the facility within 30 minutes of the end of the game.

o Is shower access allowed: Shower access is allowed subject to dressing room time allowance

o Are parents allowed to access to dressing room: facility rule is one parent per child may enter the dressing room

o **WARM UP/COOL DOWN SPACE AVAILABILITY:** Current restriction include no indoor space for warmup. Off-ice warm up to be completed in dressing room or outside facility.

o **ACCESS TO WATER BOTTLE FILL STATIONS:** each dressing room has a faucet for filling water bottles or a filling station on the bench.

o **PLAYERS AND TEAM OFFICIALS FACILITY ACCESS (HALLWAYS, LOBBY, SPECTATOR AREA):** All public areas are currently open. Concession is available for food throughout the day located on the 2 floor of main arena.

o **SKATE SHARPENING / THERAPY TABLE SET UP:** There are no skate sharpening or therapy tables available in the facility. Battle river Hockey Plus, Canadian Tire and Sport Check provide skate sharpening and hockey supplies.

o **EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN:** We are a 911 community. Hospital is located East of the recreation facility

o **BUS DROP OFF, LOADING AND PARKING:** bus drop off is located on East side of arena complex. There is bus parking in the east and north parking lots.

o VIDEO SET UP AND LIVE STREAMING (IF APPLICABLE): Our facility has free Wi-Fi

o **Spectators**: Designated spectator seating is available. <u>All spectators must be seated</u>. They are allowed entry 30 minutes prior and must vacate 30 after game or practice.

o **GENERAL FACILITY RESTRICTIONS:** Please use hand sanitizer upon entry and exit of the facility. All washroom facilities are open. Anyone with Covid-19 Symptoms is not allowed entry.

• If you bring children to the facility, they must remain seated with the parents at all times. They are NOT ALLOWED to be running around the track.

o MANAGEMENT OF SPECTATOR MAXIMUM: Maximum is 100 persons

o ENTRY AND EXIT PROCESS: Please follow arrows for traffic flow maintain social distancing

o **Time restrictions:** 30 minutes

o Specific doors: Designated doors on the East and North of arena facility

o SPECTATOR SEATING ACCESS: as marked

o ADMISSION FEES AND FORMS OF PAYMENT (IF APPLICABLE): N/A

o CONCESSION SERVICES AVAILABLE: Yes, located on the 2nd floor of Encana Arena

o Timekeepers: Must wear Masks

General Guidelines:

o Must wear a mask to at all times and maintain a minimum 2-metre social distancing in the stands with masks to stay on in any indoor public area.

o Must adhere to facility protocols (sanitization, audio equipment usage,) by Sanitizing hands upon entry and exit of facility, always remain seated
