- not use bad language, nor will I harass athletes, coaches, umpires, other spectators, or club officials by way of
 emails, voice messages, text messages (including "tweeting") and social network postings (Facebook, Snapchat,

- do my best to be a true team player by being supportive of my teammates and by not criticizing or placing blame on others
- display good sportsmanship at all times
- acknowledge that coaches and umpires are performing their duties in the best interest and abilities to the development of the players and the sport. I will accept and respect their decisions.
- understand that any violations to this code or any governing rules, policies or programs will result in disciplinary actions
- understand that if I am dismissed from the team, there will be no refund of any part of the registration or team fees paid.
