### 5. President's Report

- Good Indoor season last year.
  - $\circ$  188 registrants
  - o Multiple teams gained Provincial burst
- 516 Outdoor registrants.
  - $\circ$  1<sup>st</sup> season of the new age groups
  - Great Under the Lights Tournament
    - ▲ Strong volunteers & parents over 220 people
    - ▲ Really great response from parents
    - ★ Volunteers are critical to run this tournament successfully
    - ▲ Lots of interest for returning teams
    - We changed to a website instead of spreadsheets to track everything. This was a success and we will continue to use it.
- Camrose hosted the Tier 4 U17 Provincials.
  - $\circ$  16 teams
  - $\circ$  Both of Camrose teams placed in metals
- HUGE thank you to all Coaches, Parents, Refs and Volunteers!
- There are 40 refs now in Camrose.
- Board turnover:

- There are 170 kids registered so far for this Indoor Season.
- The Board tried to update the policies and bylaws as best as they could.
- It is URGENT that we get more volunteers to help on the Board.
  - $\circ$  Without this Board, there would be no soccer in Camrose
  - $_{\odot}$  We are all volunteers with family and fulltime jobs
  - Many hands make light work

### 6. Treasurer's Report

- Profit/Loss vs. Budget Report and Balance Sheet submitted (see attached).
- General Chequing account holds \$64,608.74.
- \$2,376.00 in NSF cheques. This is a real challenge to collect many man hours.
- Ran a loss of -\$15,963.73
  - o Mainly due to equipment that needed replacement
  - o Rock Around the Clock tournament being cancelled
  - $\circ$  Fees have not increased much for several years
    - ★ This needs to be looked at closely this year
    - It is not our target to raise fees, we need to look at getting RATC up and running or look for alternate fundraisers
- Field rentals, refs and league fees are huge expenses.
- The Night Classic Tournament raised \$24,000.
- Between expense and refs, there are about 600 cheques wrote per year.
- Anyone who is interested in helping out the Treasurer is urged to please come forward.

  - Rock Around the Clock
    - Only 8 teams registered so far (4 local)
    - o 24 teams are required to run it
    - $\circ$  It might be possible to run with a few less, just to get momentum going, depending on numbers
  - Tom and Jardath would like to move into Tier 3 & 2.
    - $\circ$  This can absolutely be looked into there was interest this year (U13)
    - o There needs to be committed players to make it viable
    - $_{\odot}$  There will be more discussion next meeting after more info is gathered
  - Jason would like to come together and take the excellent skilled kids into extra technical trainings.
    - Gradually working towards developing stronger skilled players and seeking higher tier challenges
  - Lots of discussion regarding team sizes:
    - Biggest issue is not enough players to make multiple teams leaving larger teams
    - Large drop in girls as age increases
    - $\circ$  There is concern on how players are allowed to move up
    - $\circ$  There are many different factors that contribute to making teams

- $\circ$  We want to have as many kids as possible playing, don't want to say no
- $_{\odot}$  Maximum amount of players per team is 20, with it good at 15
- Making teams is more difficult than it seems
- It is suggested to hold a meeting specifically to visually show on the screen how teams are developed
- For larger teams
  - ★ Parents are encouraged to help out the coach as much as possible
  - ★ Get out on the floor and help as the coach needs
  - Alberta Soccer offers many tools and extra help with technical trainings
