### **Referee in Chief Job Description**

#### **Introduction**

The participation of Lacrosse at the 2022 Canada Summer Games is no small task which requires a talented and dedicated team of people to help ensure that this is not a onetime event.

Successful officiating is fundamental to the success of the Canada Games. The Referee in Chief (RIC) is responsible for following the LC officiating rule book and policies manual. The RIC reports to the Lacrosse Canada Technical Representative.

The Referee In Chief is essential for the safe and successful running of this lacrosse event. The RIC will work seamlessly as part of a small team which includes the Canada Games Technical Representative, and Referee Assessor. The RIC will consult with the CG Tech Rep and Referee Assessor regarding the scheduling of all game officials.

1. Roles and Responsibilities
  - a. Referee In Chief
    - i. The RIC is responsible for managing the officiating team at the 2022 Canada Summer Games.
    - ii. The Referee In Chief should possess the following skill set:
      - A sound knowledge of Rules of Minor Lacrosse.
      - A sound knowledge of the mechanics and procedures as outlined in the Lacrosse Canada Box Lacrosse Rule Book.
      - Ideally should have officiated, assessed or has been a Referee In Chief at a Lacrosse Canada Minor Nationals event.
      - Familiar with the Lacrosse Canada Referee Assessment process.
      - Excellent Project Management Skills.
      - A sound knowledge of Microsoft Office Applications with a particular emphasis on Word and Excel.
      - Excellent organizational skills.
      - Exceptional interpersonal and communication skills.
      - Consummate team player, as the RIC will collaborate with many people at the Canada Games.
      - Available to make the commitment of volunteer time prior to, during and after the event.

#### **Compensation**

This is an unpaid position. However, all expenses related to travel, lodging, and meals will be covered.

#### **Application Process and Deadline**

Interested candidates should send their application and resume and which week of Canada Games (Female / Male) to their MA and Lacrosse Canada office for consideration.

Interviews with a shortlist of candidates will take place with the Lacrosse Canada Chair of Officials, Director of Domestic Development and Canada Games Technical Representative in early January 2022.
