Wolf Playing Lacrosse is the second (2000) in a series of limited edition prints produced by the Canadian Lacrosse Foundation to honour the game of Lacrosse and one of its greatest coaches and builders - the late Jim Bishop.

This painting was created by **Damian 'Salaston' George**, who is of the Tsileil-Watuth First Nation, which is known as the Deep Cove area. Damian is the grandson of Chief Dan George and Amy George. He is a coast Salish who was raised by his mother Amy Marie George.

Wolf Playing Lacrosse is done in a northwest coast style of aboriginal art. It is an 18x22" print on white

paper. The artwork is in red and black acrylic. The wolf is symbolic of togetherness and faith. The lead wolf watches over his pack for fairness and equality and has faith in the other pack members for its survival.
