- b) Discussion about possibility of doing anything for teams with an extended roster, decided that because there are four teams of large size that it would be challenging to the budget to anything additional for any of those teams.
- c) How are we going to manage pucks this year? Suggested that each team have a puck carrier of 50 pucks and it is each team's responsibility to track their own pucks
- ACTION: All and Brenda to look into pucks and carriers
 - d) Megan Jones asked if Sr Timbits tournament has shared or full ice? Half ice is required
- ACTION: Reid to inform Megan of the half ice requirement
 - e) The head coach of the CAHL Bantam B team wanted to know about players needing to attend the checking clinic before the exhibition game this weekend? Not a Hockey Alberta requirement, but is a requirement for CMHA, but could be done after the game.
- ACTION: Reid to inform Warren that the checking clinic is not mandatory through Hockey Alberta, but players will need to do it after the game.



- f) Locker codes for jerseys will be completely changed and only coaches and managers will have these codes. This will be taken care of once Gary McLaughlin has returned.
- g) Concerns heard from parents during this year's evaluations: why is a coach's skate necessary? When a parent is asked to help during a Coach's skate should it be a board member? Be mindful of the perception that gives other parents.
- h) Discussion about having the goalie development committee meet
- ACTION: Goalie Development Committee to figure out a time to meet before the next board meeting
 - Coach/Manager meeting with all the teams needs to be set-up with Carrie, Sara, Reid, Al, and Sean D. Decided to separate the two sessions between House/Girls and CAHL. Initiation, Jr and Sr Timbits will have a separate meeting day and time.
- ACTION: Carrie to send information to Sarah to post of website for the Coach/Manager meetings to happen on Wednesday, October 4 at the Rec Centre (Sara to book a location) 6pm 7pm for House/Girls and 7:30pm 8:30pm for CAHL. Cheryl to write up some information to share with these groups, as she will be away.
