1. Approval of August 22, 2017 Meeting MInutes

<u>MOTION:</u> To approve the August 22, 2017 meeting minutes as presented **Moved;** Sara; **seconded;** Sarah; **carried**

2. Registration

- a) Discussion regarding this year's registration numbers and further discussion regarding the number of teams per division and levels.
- b) Brief discussion regarding changes to House, which is now called Rockies Hockey League and an update about other associations doing soft evaluations to tier their teams. Other associations can choose to follow suit or not, but will leave their teams facing tougher competition if they do not tier within their association



- ACTION: Sean D to draft a communication to membership regarding the changes from House to the Rockies Hockey League for Sara and Sean K to review and then Sarah will send out to membership
- c) Brenda talked about transfers and refunds through PayPal and the costs associated. CMHA has no choice but to use PayPal since it was negotiated through Goalline.
- ACTION: Cheques to be written for smaller amounts and otherwise refunds can be issued through PayPal
- d) Hockey Canada is now open so Carrie can start registering players.

3. Coach Coordinator Report, Evaluation Planning and Procedures

- a) Review of Evaluation Division Supervisor Duties, no changes to be made
- b) Review of flowcharts, changes of some wording on the Novice flowchart
- ACTION: Reid to make changes to the Novice flowchart
- ACTION: Reid to work on a flow chart for goalies and forward to Sara and Sean K for review
- c) Review of Evaluation Procedure Players and Goalies, longer discussion on the weighting of skills and game play for each level based on Hockey Canada guidelines. Goalies do not go to the skills sessions, only games. Groups will be posted close to the evaluations.
- ACTION: Reid to update the Evaluation Procedures with changes to wording and adding an appendix for goalies and send to Sara for review. Once changes have been approved then they will be posted on the CMHA website.

- f) Discussion regarding trial use of Team Genius with the Canmore Eagles for their fitness tests. Good test run. Eagles agreed to help with the cost of Team Genius for this year's evaluations. Board went through a test run of Team Genius to see how it works and the information provided once completed.

Two Board members will be supervising each level during evaluations, must ensure that there is a warm-up, referees, a volunteer for gates, a volunteer for the clock. A reminder that Novice/Atom players play all positions. A reminder that girls trying out for PeeWee, Bantam and Midget and attending conditioning camps require separate dressing rooms.

4. CAHL Director Report

Season Starts October 13

Tiering Round October 13 – November 5

Regular Season November 17/17 – February 18/18, Christmas Break December 22-31 Playoff Season February 23 – March 25/18

5. Tournament Allocation

Choosing of tournaments for the 2017/18 hockey season that will be hosted in Canmore:

November: Atom (3 teams)

December: Midget CAHL and RHL

January: Girls (2 teams, PeeWee and Midget)

February: CAHL Novice (2 teams)

March: two tournaments to be split between JR and SR Timbits

Megan Jones is the tournament coordinator, she would like 12 teams vs 8 teams for each tournament. Bunny suggested that each year we have Timbits, Atom and Midget every year and then draw from the other teams to fill the other slots. Board approved this idea.

• ACTION: Cheryl to confirm December dates with Megan, need to ensure none of the tournament weekends have an Eagles game on the Friday night.



6. RHL Update

Rockies Hockey League is now an official entity within Hockey Alberta. The RHL Board requires pictures of Canmore players for the website.

Discussion about keeping players information confidential, will use the same protocol that is used for CAHL

RHL has eliminated the three penalty rule and gone to total penalty time minutes, as they do in CAHL.

Discussed the RHL budget

Reviewed that games are 90 minute stop time, Novice is kept at 1 hour.

RHL requires a Governor from each participating association, unclear whether it can be the Board member? CMHA would need to change our bylaws if we require a separate person to act as Governor.

New this year a \$200 performance bond per team from each association to a max of \$1000, need more information regarding the what is the criteria for performance?

 ACTION: Sean D to get information regarding the Governor position and the performance bond

Bunny believes there is a bond for the female leagues as well

• ACTION: Bunny to get more information regarding fees vs bond

Procedure to book referees: Cheryl to send an email to Irv all the games for Fri, Sat and Sun and then goes out to managers. Irv sends Cheryl the bill, which is then double checked before being forwarded to Brenda.
