1) Review of the June 7, 2018 Meeting Minutes

MOTION: To approve the June 7, 2018 meeting minutes Moved; Mike H.; seconded; Reid; carried

2) Ice Coordinator Update

- Close to finalizing ice allocations for conditioning camps, waiting on TOC September ice
- Cochrane AA and Airdrie AA and AAA evaluations schedule is available
- Andrew from the Eagles has confirmed players will be available for evaluations and might add a 3rd coach and have three ice surfaces for evaluations
- Al brought up logistics to ensure that all players from the same level be evaluated by the same evaluators each time

3) Registrar Update – Registration numbers



- 321 players registered by June 30, last year was 259 at the same time, Morley late registrations last year affected the September numbers
- Review of registration numbers and decisions about which levels to remain open for registration and which levels would close and additional registrants would go on a wait list
- Review of conditioning camp numbers and which camps are now closed because they are full and which stay open for registration. Ice allocation discussed for the four camps.

4) Goalies Development – Review meeting

- Review of goalie committee meeting with Justin Cardinal from Evolution Goaltending
- 2018/19 season will have Intro to Goaltending, Goalie Clinics (mostly held in Canmore due to locker room key issue in Banff), Goalie Mentorships (which include journal writing, mental preparedness, pregame routines)
- Justin to provide a package for coaches to be shared on Hockeyshare with suggestions on goalie coaching during practices
- Work with parents on educating them on the position of goaltending and coaches to encourage players to try out the position at the Novice level and encourage having two goaltenders from Atom and up

5) Coach Coordinator Update

- Reid presented his report to the board
- ACTION: Reid to send out a rough draft of the evaluations flow chart to the board before the next meeting
- Update of CMHA equipment and paperwork being stored in a container while the Rec Centre is under renovation
- ACTION: To clean out the storage room before all the equipment needs to come back
- Discussion about eliminating the Coach's pick skate during evaluations, because almost all the coaches last year used Team Genius for their team picks

MOTION: To remove the Coach's skate for the evaluation process for the 2018/19 season. Moved; Mike H.; seconded; Sara; carried. Opposed Al and Sean.

• ACTION: Carrie to amend the description for CAHL on the CMHA website removing the Coach's skate

6) Girls League Director

• Discussion regarding registration numbers and the search for an Atom goalie.



ACTION: Bunny to review the players who have already registered and reach out to other players
who have not yet registered. Bunny working on the September weekend which could see more
players register.

7) House League Updates

- Sean would like to congratulate Mandy Grant for being nominated as team manager of the year and
 Seam Kjemius for being nominated as coach of the year. Thanks for their hard work.
- Review of possibility of having an RHL Junior team in Canmore. Support is strong in Okotoks, Airdrie and Cochrane. The league would not have practices, but have one refereed game per week.
- ACTION: Carrie to email parents with 2000, 1999, and 1998 born players to find out interest and request to collect deposits, deadline is July 15 for commitment.
- RHL decided that 90 minutes is not enough ice time for games, moving up to 2 hrs of ice for all levels.
- Review of changes to the penalty structure for teams and players
- Review of the tiering process in RHL is left to the governors and directors to tier their teams appropriately. There is flexibility to move players is there is more than one team.
- Estimated CMHA teams need to be submitted by August 15, the HCR needs to be submitted before the season starts.
- Communications protocol will be enforced in RHL for the 2018/19 season, directors need to be approached first before approaching the RHL board with any issues/grievances
- No formal evaluations for RHL teams, however three will be a skate if there is more than one team in a division.

• Review of the last year's budget, still waiting on the June statement to complete the year and send to the accountant for year end. CMHA will finalize the budget for the 2018/19 season at the next meeting.
