



Canora Minor Hockey COVID- 19 Guidelines

** In Addition to all Hockey Canada, Sask Hockey, and Town of Canora Policies**

- Participants that live in town are asked to come dressed, 10 minutes prior to practice time, and sit on the players bench to put skates on. Do not enter the dressing rooms. At the end of practice remove skates and undress at home.
- Participants that live out of town may utilize the dressing rooms, come 20 minutes prior to practice.
- Maximum 6 players per dressing room if parents are present and helping. Maximum 8 per dressing room if no parents. Each team will be allotted 2 dressing rooms. (Girls dressing room available but needs to be prebooked)
- Parents of U11 teams and older are asked not to be in dressing rooms to allow space for the players to dress. If a player needs their skates tied they will go to the players bench and meet their parent there.
- For games arrive NO MORE THAN 30 minutes prior to your scheduled game time
- All Participants, Parents, Spectators and Guardians are asked to leave the facility with in 15 minutes of practice or games ending—No Loitering
- Please pack a prevention kit in your childs bag. This includes: hand sanitizer, facial tissues, a spare mask, and disinfecting wipes.

Other important things to remember:

- Bring water bottles prefilled and labelled.
- No Food or Drink in the dressing rooms
- Masks are mandatory at all times for everyone. Players, Coaches, and Officials may have their mask off when they are on ice only
- Facility capacity is 120 in the stands, 30 in the lobby.
- Self Monitoring and regulation of rules is essential for our success.
