

Thank you for joining us for the 1st Annual Ron Huckla Memorial Tournament. All games will be held at the **Grant Harvey Centre, 600 Knowledge Park Drive**. There will be a monitor with assigned dressing rooms. There will be female dressing rooms assigned to each pad. Please reach out to the tournament co-chairs with questions.

Game Format:

- 3 minute warm up. Will start once all previous players and personnel have cleared the bench. (floor is accessible for both teams)
- 3x15 periods
- 3 minute intermission
- 3rd period Last 3 minutes will be stop time within 5 goals.
- Oncoming teams must be ready to start at their designated start time as per schedule.
- Dressing rooms must be cleared and accessible 15 minutes after game.

Tie-Breaker:

The tie-break regulation to determine tournament standing will be as follows:

- 1. most points (2 for win, 1 for tie, 0 loss)
- 2. most wins
- 3. fewest penalty minutes
- 4. quickest goal in first game of the tournament
- 5. coin flip

The rules regarding standings encourages teams from running up the score. Goals for and against are not determining factors.

Player of the Game:

There will be player of the game awards for each team at the end of each game. We ask coaches to pick a player from their own team that has demonstrated qualities of sportsmanship, drive, and teamwork over the game. These are the qualities we want to highlight in our Player of the game.

Play-off/Championship Game:

1. Add 5 minutes of overtime as needed 5vs 5 (use the full 5 minutes)

2. Shoot out if still tied: 3 players selected, total goals.

3. If still tied, sudden death shoot out, 1 player at a time. All players must be used before players can re-attempt. If 1 team has fewer players, once that team exhausts all players and must re-use a player, the opposing team may also commence re-using their players, even if all their players have not yet competed.

Rules and Regulations:

- Zero wall ball anywhere inside the facility.
- Teams are responsible for their player's actions on and off the floor inside or out.
- All Lacrosse Canada rules are in effect U11-U15.
- U9 rules are as communicated to teams.
- Fighting Major or any (2) 10 minutes misconducts or game misconducts in the tournament will results in banishment from the tournament.
- There will be zero abuse tolerated of referees, players, coaches or volunteers.

Safety is our #1 priority

All majors will be reviewed by the RHM Tournament discipline hearing committee which will consist of the co-chairs, OIC, and 2 outside parties.

Metals and Ron Huckla Cup:

Metals will be awarded at each Championship game. The Ron Huckla Cup will be available for a short amount of time for pictures at the end of the game. U9 teams will all receive ribbons.

Food:
