### WHY ARE NEW DIAMONDS NECESSARY

- I. Increased numbers of registrants will exceed available playing space by 2019 & 2020
- 2. Players are leaving Carman Minor Ball to participate in other surrounding communities due to lack of development opportunities, teams and competition
- 3. Our community is unable to host league, regional and provincial tournaments for certain age categories due to lack of high caliber facilities
- 4. Current facilities may be lost in the near future due to other regional plans for the community land
- 5. Provides a framework and facilities that have safe playing conditions by providing increase economic benefits for the community

### **SALES FAQ:**

- Currently CMB has 6 diamonds but the new plan shows 8. Why are we expanding?
  - Necessary for growing grassroots programs as number of registrants increases in 2019 & 2020
  - Strong athletes leaving the area to play on regional teams and we do not have the facilities to accommodate these teams
  - We do not have sufficient space to host tournaments
- What is the \$1M building complex budget based upon?
  - Based on a number of local contractors and 3<sup>rd</sup> party quotes
  - Feel the number on some of the electrical and water services will be reduced to service in kind donations
- Is the Town of Carman and Dufferin Recreation Center in support of the project?
  - They acknowledge the need for facilities
  - We are working together to get support in services and financially but nothing committed as of yet
- What is the estimated timeline for this project to break ground?
  - Depending on \$ raised. But our hope is to break ground in fall of 2019 if we have enough money to build 3 diamonds
- When is the project estimated to be completed?
  - All depends upon funds raised. But if we happen to raise all of the funds. The kids would be able to begin to play ball late in 2020 or for the start of the 2021 ball season
- How will contributions be recognized?
  - We are still working through different ideas on this currently. But the goal is to recognize all sponsors in some type of sponsorship board at the ball facility. Looking for more ideas to ensure we provide the right recognition for business and individual donors.
