## **HEALTH & SAFETY**

#### **EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN (EAP)**

An Emergency Action Plan (EAP) is a plan designed to assist Safety Personnel in responding to emergency situations in a responsible and clear-headed way.

CAUSES FOR IMMEDIATE ACTIVATION OF EAP There must be immediate action of the EAP if the injured person:

- Is not breathing
- Does not have a pulse
- Is bleeding profusely
- Has impaired consciousness
- Has injured the back, neck and/or head
- Has a visible major trauma to a limb
