

CDMFA UPDATE Aug.5th, 2020

Due to many factors the CDMFA is unable to offer programs for all clubs at all contact levels. As a result of this, there will be no CDMFA scheduled, sanctioned competition between CDMFA clubs for the month of August. We will review this and announce how the CDMFA will proceed in September

The factors that influenced this decision are as follows:

- CDMFA member teams and clubs are varied and conflicted as to their approach to games for the 2020 season
- Standards we have set for CDMFA Sanctioned Competition must be maintained despite the limitations of the COVID pandemic
- Ability to assure compliance with guidelines from Alberta Health Services, Football Alberta and Football Canada.
- Risk Assessment for the CDMFA, it's Member Clubs and their participants (Families)

How does this affect CDMFA club activity in August?

- Practices and scrimmages within a club are permitted if guidelines from Alberta Health Services, Football Alberta are followed.
- Clubs that wish to make arrangements for inter-club scrimmages, or game activities, may apply to be sanctioned by the CDMFA Board
- The CDMFA assumes no liability for unsanctioned Activities by CDMFA Member Clubs

Requirements for CDMFA Sanctioned Competition will be sent out later this week.
