**Game Sheets:**

- 2025 game sheets are single Print copy. Only Game sheets printed From the Website will be accepted, no handwritten Game sheets
- **Each Team will receive a login specific to their team, these will be sent to your club for distribution**
- Click on League games, then the Printer ICON for Home or Away to Print your Game sheet
- Jersey numbers added in when you log in, so they will appear on your game sheet. Coaches MUST Print their Name and sign the game sheet, agreeing to the results. **ALL BENCH PERSONNEL MUST BE LISTED ON EVERY GAME SHEET**, Please remember the RULE OF TWO – FOUND HERE [RULE OF TWO POLICY](#)

**Team Rosters:**

- Note players may only play on one team within the season with the exception of playing up ie. U11 player playing for developmental purposes to a U13 team – limited to 5 games. Please refer to C.A.S.A Rules and Regulations for clarification and the Rules on Playing Up in a Tournament.
- These players may be handwritten onto the Game sheet and marked as a Call-UP

**Rescheduling of Games** – The procedure for rescheduling of games is as follows

- Please contact your opposing Coach if the game has been canceled. Determine a day and time that is acceptable to both teams. The game does not need to be played on your regular League Night
- Email the CASA Office at [admin@centralalberta.soccer](mailto:admin@centralalberta.soccer) with the new date and time

**Reschedule of games will be permitted for the following reasons**

- Weather – Lightning – just rain is not a reason to cancel
- Smoke
- Fields closed by your Local City- town
- Other reasons will be considered on a case-by-case basis
