



### Season Information for CASA Referee

Ensure that all adults who are on the bench are written on the game sheet - including bench moms or dads. Their name needs to be on the sheet and they should show ID (coach card or driver's license) as well.

- Digital cards are permitted in special circumstances (cards were forgotten, etc.) Record on game sheet if they used digital cards.
- Ensure sheets are completed as per earlier email. Make sure to send picture of sheet to Tammy after you've filled it out.
- U9 is 6v6 in CASA not 7v7. All other rules for U9 are as per ASA's 7v7 rules.
- Substitutions - the number of substitutions at one stoppage should not be limited - this is not supported in the laws or by ASA.
- Jewellery and casts and thunder and air quality - ensure that the law about jewellery and the policies on casts and thunder and air quality are followed. Use the cards you were given at your courses and Law 4 to support you!
- Dissent - it is expected that we all deal with dissent together. Dissent needs to be dealt with early and consistently. Ensure to build rapport with coaches and players before the game starts and during the game. Then ensure to know what is a warning, what is a caution and what is a send off for team officials from Law 12. This is not only to help you, but all the officials that a team works with after you.
