

## CENTRAL OKANAGAN YOUTH SOCCER ASSOCIATION (COYSA) PARENT/GUARDIAN COMMITMENT / CODE OF CONDUCT and COYSA PARTICIPANT COMMITMENT / CODE OF CONDUCT

This Parent/Guardian Commitment / Code of Conduct and COYSA Participant Commitment / Code of Conduct forms part of your participant's registration. By registering your participant with COYSA, you are agreeing to adhere to the requirements as listed below.

## AS A COYSA PARENT/GUARDIAN I AGREE THAT:

- My participant will arrive at all games 15 minutes prior to the start time.
- My participant will be ready to go with uniform and all required equipment on, 15 minutes prior to the specified start time for the games.
- I will notify the coach directly if my participant will be absent from any game.
- I will remain in the designated spectator area. I will NOT approach the bench during a game unless instructed to do so.
- I will let the coaches do their job. I will NOT coach or give sideline directions to any players.
- I will set a good example for my participant; good sportsmanship is not just for players and coaches.
- I will respect the match officials' (referee) decisions and not discuss calls with them. Referee's can have offensive parents/guardians removed from the field and if they refuse the match will be forfeited to the opponent.
- I will NOT participate in any negative sideline discussions.
- I will NEVER criticize a player for a mistake.
- I will applaud effort and good play, as well as success.
- I will remember Children play for FUN! These are KIDS. This is a GAME. Coaches are VOLUNTEERS and Referees are HUMAN.

## AS A COYSA PARTICIPANT I AGREE THAT:

- I will attend all games. If I am unable to attend, I will notify my coach directly.
- I will arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of games.
- I understand that fair play and a positive attitude are always expected.
- I will always show my teammates respect and try to encourage them and help them to succeed.
- I will always treat my opponents with respect.
- I will not argue with match officials, and I will treat them with respect.
- I will not argue with my coach, and I will treat them with respect.
- I will demonstrate good sportsmanship, whether we win or lose.
- I understand that there is a zero-tolerance policy for profanity, temper tantrums or violent behavior.
