PRESENTATION OF AGENDA

APPROVAL of MINUTES of the May 12, 2022 board meeting

<u>June 09, 2022 Motion #1113</u> It was moved and seconded to accept the minutes of the May 12, 2022 regular board meeting as presented. Carried by unanimous consent.

CHAIR REPORT – Welcome Jon from OMYSA. Club Chair meeting where main topic was whether we should merge with TOYDA. Met with TODAY Chair Frank and they aren't interested in joining. Everyone wants to continue TOYSL. One possibility might be Penticton joining us, then there'd be two Districts: North and South. Attended BCSA SGM on governance issues by Zoom. Adults are 13% of registration, youth 87% but each has 50% of vote. Forums and meetings were held to outline the change (1 vote for every 2500). CSA said it has to happen as we are not currently aligned with FIFA, CONCACAF, etc and there would be sanctions if not done. Motion was denied. Sanctions could be financial or no Nationals but nothing confirmed. Historically adults have blocked anything proportionate, as they would no longer have control. Next weekend we have BU18 Kelowna Cup and Select Playdowns.

BOOKKEEPER REPORT – written report. \$121,000 paid to BCSA. Second assessment in September about \$20/pp.

REFEREE REPORT – Took the "refer fee" suggestion to KMSL and they feel they do enough for refs. KWSL haven't responded. This weekend BU14 at Beasley won't have a ref. Next weekend most of COYSA games will be without refs because of Playdowns and PCSL games. Q: Can we do anything through schools? A: Tried but BCSA said no. They want it done their way: 17 modules online then Zoom. What about an incentive for getting refs? Adult leagues should require one person per team take the course. KMSL likes that idea.

<u>Travel fees (refs)</u> – Paid to go to LCYSA and WYSA as they are short but have lots in town. Only done if we can't fill from the area. Lots of extra work as it has to be manually added to payroll. This year is an anomaly with some WYSA/LCYSA refs coming into town. Let's leave alone this year. We are rebuilding.

DISCIPLINE REPORT – written report. Numbers down. LCYSA had discussion with BU18 and apology is in the works.

<u>U9 Offsides</u> – Complaint about standing next to goal "cherry picking". No offsides at this age. Please remind teams this is not in spirit of game or development.

<u>Mini Jamboree</u> – Issue with District of Lake Country; they want a parking plan. DLC offered Swallwell field and GESS. Teams wouldn't need to go to Beasley for lunch. LCYSA working on it.

<u>U18 Kelowna Cup</u> – Stuart reffing. Carl offered to help. As Vice Chair, April should do trophy presentation.

<u>Select Playdowns</u> - U13 and U15 are round robin so regardless of result, pks have to be done as a 3 game RR could end up in a tie break situation.
