

Please reinforce these items with your groups. This is going to all our users so it is not directed at one specific group.

1. Use of the facility is a privilege, not a right.
2. The lobby is for the enjoyment of all our patrons. Children need to be supervised. This is not an area for shooting pucks or balls or running around playing tag. We have injured people visiting the Sports Medicine Clinic and seniors that visit the library. They need to be able to feel safe and not at risk of flying projectiles or children running around. Elevators are not there to keep children occupied, they are for our patrons that have issues climbing or descending stairs.
3. Pets are not permitted in the facility. We have a food licence that does not allow for animals in the building.
4. Just because a field is not in use it does not mean you can go on it. You do not go into a theatre and say there is an empty seat so you should be able to sit in it!
5. Dressing rooms have garbage bins and recycling bins. Tape balls and garbage go into the garbage bin and cans go into recycling. You don't throw garbage on your floors at home, don't do it here! The photo example is not acceptable. Groups that leave rooms in an unacceptable condition may be invoiced for cleaning. If you enter a room that is not clean or there are items that are damaged upon arrival please advise us at the office or call our engineer on duty at 250-864-1806 for MNP Place and 250-979-0888 at Prospera Place
6. You are entitled to enter the dressing rooms assigned 30 minutes prior to a game and you must be out within 45 minutes of the end of your ice time.
7. Covid19 shutdowns may be over but spitting is still not permitted in dressing rooms, player benches, lobbies, spectator areas. Much like inside your home!
8. Alcohol is not permitted in the dressing rooms or public spectating / lobby areas. Our liquor licence in Boomers (open late for your after event needs) / Manhattan Point can be revoked if a liquor inspector comes by and sees alcohol consumption in the building other than Boomers.
9. Food and drink is not permitted on the turf fields. Sunflower seeds are punishable by a severe flogging as well as a cleaning bill!

1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8 also applies to Prospera Place.
