### PRESENTATION OF AGENDA

APPROVAL of MINUTES of the February 12, 2025 regular board meeting.

<u>March 13, 2025 Motion #1159</u> It was moved and seconded to accept the minutes of the February 12, 2025 regular board meeting as presented. Carried by unanimous consent.

**BOOKKEEPER REPORT** – First assessment bill will be sent early April. Q: Assessment number for fall? Use current rate; revisiting after fall.

**REFEREE REPORT** – Been a battle to get courses approved. First Entry Level has 23. Haven't heard of experienced refs not returning. Numbers aren't bad, lacking experience. Kits handed out at courses. Potential new program cost jumped from \$1500US to \$5000US. Not changing. Travel fees: WYSA/LCYSA usually short so paid extra for refs to go. Last year was first time brought in from LCYSA; they had great recruiting. Short on Small Sided refs. Fill first from those closest. Fee is \$15. Q: Who schedules/looks after PFC refs? Game in Penticton, PFC schedules/pays. PFC pays different COYSA assessment rate. Used to have a head ref. Al happy to advise/help. Course needs gym and class, one month notice. Ref scheduling priority is highest level first.

<u>March 13, 2025 Motion #1160</u> It was moved and seconded to pay officials a travel fee for leaving their municipality. Carried by unanimous consent.

**DISCIPLINE REPORT** – No incidents last month. First time since Discipline Chair started.
