PRESENTATION OF AGENDA

APPROVAL of MINUTES of the April 08, 2021 regular Board meeting

CHAIR REPORT – Chairs meeting last week with BCSA about proposed Super District. General feeling seems to be that a Super District would add little, if anything, to COYSA Clubs at this time. Next week have a BCSA Youth Forum Meeting.

TREASURER REPORT – Not much to update. One outside user group wants to book our field; preparing contract for that. Urban Rec aren't allowed to play yet.

REFEREE REPORT – Courses are planned. Entry Level only has 3 registered so that will be delayed or cancelled. Two Small Sided courses. If soccer gets going, will have Small Sided Refs but only a quarter of normal. Don't have many District Level. Courses have an in person session. Had some Head Ref sessions with BCSA. Heard adults may be given the "good to go" on the 24th. A: How do we advertise courses? Club websites, FaceBook and Admins forwarded. Is there an easier to understand outline without having to read pages and pages?

BUSINESS: CARRIED FORWARD / NEW BUSINESS

U18s – OMYSA / WYSA don't have teams. LCYSA has none, KYSA numbers really low. RYSA have U18s with U16s. Not enough interest/time to have a season. Release fields.

CLUB REPORTS:

KUFC – Not too much to report, rolling along, working on National License. Biggest frustration is having OFC show up and video tape sessions.

KYSA – Nothing since last time, handed out equipment, coaches on pitches, waiting for green light.

LCYSA – Nothing too exciting, going well with Whitecaps doing plans.

OMYSA – Having skills clinics with KU coaches, no teams. Felt with volunteers, wouldn't be controls for social distancing and protocols to be followed. Went to professional coaches, all in one place. Hoping for a fall season.

RYSA – Been doing practices for 2 or 3 weeks and it's going well, lots of new registrants. Good to see different sports out. Castanet showed adults in team uniforms. Everybody is trying their best to put a safe environment for the kids and this kind of thing is not helpful. Q: What is the OFC video thing? Been coming to KU practices and video taping. Board members spoke with them and they want to send to Interior Health (IH) and ask if it was okay; seems like trying to "catch" problems with physical distancing. OFC thought we were sending in complaints about them, which we were not. Lots of volunteer coaches and maybe they make a mistake or kids bump into each other. If we saw another Club, I think

we would talk to them, not be reporting. Truly believe all the youth Clubs are doing everything to keep it safe. Q: Is it legal to video kids? In a public place it's allowed but had some angry fathers over it. Makes people uncomfortable. Don't want to get into tit for tat. Crazy another Club would do that to us. Saw men have full contact soccer at 4:30 at night. Tattletales hurt everyone. OFC was photographed in Westside dome and were kicked out for being too close. WYSA – Pretty much all the teams are practicing with guidelines. Great turnouts.

Will see some of you Saturday, some next week. Will probably need a meeting after the 25th announcement.
