



Proof of Vaccination Facility Requirements Guide – Sept 29, 2021

- All adult sport participants 22 years of age or older require proof of full vaccination (PoV)*. All participants first & last names and telephone number will be recorded.
- All youth sport participants up to 22 years of age are exempt from having to show PoV.
- If indoor spectator group is 10 or fewer **OR** outdoor spectator group is 50 or fewer, there is no requirement for PoV for any event (youth or adult). Groups must decide to either limit spectator group (no PoV) or exceed limit (check all PoV) prior to event to ensure compliance.
- Spectators 12 years & older at gatherings over spectator limit must show proof of vaccination, whether ticketed or non-ticketed sport events*.
- Adults involved as coaches, conveners, referees and staff supporting youth sport are exempt from the requirement to show proof of vaccination.
- Parents and support persons acting in a service capacity to facilitate youth sport are exempt.
- Masks are required upon entry for those 12 years & older. Masks are not required while on the ice surface or field of play. Spectators are required to wear masks.
- **Rental / User Groups** – Minor Hockey, Figure Skating, Jets, Pickleball, etc. will be required to manage and monitor their participants, officials & spectators to ensure compliance for all requirements of this guide, current PHO orders and both user group & facility Covid Safety Plans. Indoor facility users are also subject to **50%** capacity limits. IE 207 people for SSC Rink 3. Each group must provide a **Covid Safety Ambassador** (see below).
- Drop-in public & recreational skating events do not require proof of vaccination. Drop in sport skating events (including figure skating) do require proof of vaccination.

*those 19 years of age or older who require proof of vaccination will also need to show their government issued photo ID. Proof of vaccination requires full vaccination for admittance.

User Group **Covid Safety Ambassador**

Each team or rental group must have a “**Covid Safety Ambassador**” to supervise the group, provide access to authorized individuals, enforce Covid protocols required by the Public Health Officer (ie masking or Vaccination requirements), and ensure that occupancy limits have not been exceeded.
