2. Call to Order @ 6:30pm

3. Approvals

- Minutes from the June 17th, July 8th and July 15th meetings to be approved
 - o Mike and Lee agree to the amendment in the June 17th meeting minutes.

Lee motions to approve the July 8th board meeting minutes, seconded by Chantelle. All in favour, motion carried

Chantelle motions to approve the July 15th board meeting minutes, seconded by Avalon. All in favour, motion carried

4. Ice Coordinator Update - Ron

- Short ice, only gained 6 hours with new rink which isn't enough based on registration numbers
 - o Lost blue ice (Chiefs sheet) Saturday and Sundays
- City pushed back ice slot start times to 4pm (rink closes earlier use to be 10:30 now 8:30/9:30) too early for association to have ice that early so some start times will be 4:45pm, 5pm, and 5:30pm
 - o which allows more game slots to be more reasonable
- Winter closure dates decided by board to be December 23rd, 2019 to January 6th, 2020
- Initiation start date decide by board o be mid-September
 - o Suggestion that Hockey ½ have development in September- separate age groups
 - o Ron and Jason set up a schedule and proposal for Hockey 1-4
- Female:
 - o If we end up with 3 teams we will have enough ice
 - o Ron is working on schedule with rotating practices
 - o Teams will get 1 extra evaluation time each
- Suggestion: 6am practices
 - o Move rep to mornings 6am only no more rotation with C division and novice
 - o Rep players show dedication and want to play high level
 - o C division players barley shows up
 - Board decided that the 6am practices will continue to be shared Rep and C Division
 - If there's push back from membership we stand strong in providing fairness throughout association

Ross motions that C Division and Rep teams have the same amount of 6am practices, seconded by Chantelle. All in favour, 1 abstention (Krista), motion carried.

5. Equipment Manager Update - Jack and Charmaine

- No prior inventory list of what we own as association has been made and kept
 - o Example: number of puck bag etc...
 - o Jack and Charmaine putting together so supplies can be monitored
- Previous Equipment Managers only provided a binder with return sheets
- Brian at Cheam:
 - Please order what we are missing Sponsorship bars missing when kids kept jersey
- Suggestion to raise jersey deposit to \$150 to cover sponsor bars
- Possibility to purchase jersey by December for \$100
- Problems:
 - o Missing jerseys get replaced but forgetting to add sponsor name
 - Jerseys not coming back the way they should
 - Charmaine taking off C's and A's
 - Lots of damage to jerseys already only a couple years old
 - Jerseys not allowed to be worn during practice reinforce
 - We new getting new jerseys that rep would only last 2 years
 - Andreas suggestion we have discussed before
 - Kids buying jersey in registration fee
 - One year white, next year black
 - o Chilliwack ortho missing sponsors bars on some of the jerseys
 - Question:
 - Do we get them made the same or get a whole new set made in CMHA colours?
 - Board agrees to redo with CMHA colours look more uniform
- Sapphire Sponsor:
 - o Charmaine shows sample of sponsor bar on jerseys
 - o Board to agree and go ahead yes, looks great!
 - o Colours will remain the same as Chilliwack colour not sponsor colour
- C's and A's Pat designed with no clue so after we attached/sew and wash glue doesn't mess up jersey
 - o Coaches purchase for teams
 - o Suggestion to equipment managers to order more A's than C's
 - o Teams use Kristina to get them sewed on Charmaine to contact
- Old coordinators ordered new pucks
- Evaluation Jerseys speak with Jason
- Jerseys give out draft nights coaches sign for at rink
 - o Wont hand out team jersey until evaluation jersey handed back in
 - Kid signs for evaluation jersey at evaluations return cleaned
- Outdated goal equipment 15 set of goal pads can we donate to school district for floor hockey program?
 - o Initiation 1-4 get two sets per team for cross ice need to make sure we have enough
- Old McDonalds tuques-

- o Charmaine works for school district and sees lots of kids come to school without them
- o The board agrees to donate to school, charities and community services
- Few more days to get ready except missing jerseys so will keep plugging along
- Jerseys:
 - o Figure out how much you need so board can approve ordering
- Complaint about white jerseys put on wet on metal hangers rust marks
- First aid kits:

 - o Add band aids and extra ice packs

- Deadline for jersey deposit due date coach manager package

 - Teresa not all organizations require financial assessment (Kidsport)
 - We need clarity around messaging
 - Check and balance, proof
 - Suggestion: If the family can only get kid sport its not enough to get funding from CMHA
 - Equipment donated trough Cheam Bowls of Hope picture taken of player and
 Charmaine sent to Cheam and Bowls of Hope

Krista motions that Chilliwack Minor Hockey aids family X \$1100.00 for registration (not including rep fees), seconded by Chantelle. All in favour except for 2 abstentions, motion carried
