Over 150 development sessions have been performed

Problems that we have faced:

- Practice times vs number of games especially in October (some teams only practiced twice in the month of October)
- Conflicting practice times
- Not enough development staff for players
- Monday night goalie sessions Drew Martz's goalie group is in Hope so we need to bring outside people in
- Managers and coaches do not communicate their practice times so I have to track them down through the website which is time consuming
- It is much easier to receive their schedule and forward it to the development staff

Development Plan for Next Season

Prep Camp

I would offer the two week program in the evenings again. The price needs to increase. Set the maximum number for each group including goalies. I would set it at 28 players and 4 goalies.

$$32 \times $250 = $8,000$$

5 age groups = \$40,000

Possible age groups include novice, atom, peewee, bantam and midget.

Hockey School

CMHA should offer a full day hockey camp with specialized coaches and fitness trainers. We have a good location that can provide the ice, lunch room, and fields for outdoor activities. The target age groups should be Novice, Atom, Peewee and Possibly a small Bantam group.

Structure

- 5 days
- 30 plus 4 goalies Max
- **\$700**

- 3 hours of ice daily
- 2.5 of off-ice training (team building, off ice challenges, fun component)
- Specific Goalie Training during ice times

Revenue (2 weeks)

\$95,200

Expenses

- Instructors
- Ice time
- Jerseys
- Pizza on Friday
- Camp Director
- Counsellors (junior instructors)

Rep Evaluation Process

It is my opinion that we should move to an outside evaluator process. I recommend that we use personal from outside the lower mainland so there are no personal connections. I can assembly the staff, organize the structure of the tryout process, and coordinate all score reporting by incorporating the team genius app.

Why use Team genius?

- Customize our evaluation form
- Replaces all paper forms
- Evaluators download the app and enter their ratings and comments
- Offline mode
- See immediate player rankings, run reports, email results and team placements
- Cost is 4 dollars per year for each player we can use this app to assess players throughout the season
- They provide training for the app

Structure

- Need to start a little earlier
- Need to have the ice time organized
- Need more ice time for smaller groups
- Run one session that is completely skill analysis then inter-squad games after
- Increase our rep tryout fee
- Need to purchase new goalie jerseys for evaluations
- Players must pay for rep tryouts and must be paid in full, on payment plan or receiving funding to eligible

Cost

- 20-30K Plus ice time
