

# CNN SPURS MINOR HOCKEY

## ELITE STREAM AND FEMALE PLAYER MOVEMENT PROCESSES

It is that time of year again, summer has finally shown up and hockey registration is entering all our minds once again. Every year there are always questions around the correct process for AAA, AA and/or female player movement. I will explain each process here to assist anyone that is not familiar or needs a refresher.

### AAA

If you are pursuing AAA hockey and reside within the boundaries of CNN Minor Hockey, you **MUST** try out for the Fort Saskatchewan AAA team.

- The first thing you need to do is register with CNN Minor Hockey. No AAA try out forms will be signed without the player being registered.
- Then complete the 2019-20 AAA Try Out Form (posted on the CNN website). Incomplete forms will not be signed.
- Send the completed 2019-20 AAA Try Out Form to the CNN President at [president@cnnspurs.com](mailto:president@cnnspurs.com). The President will:
  - Review the form to ensure that it is properly completed
  - Confirm the players registration with CNN for the 2019-20 season
  - Sign the form and send it back to the email address that the form was received from. The CNN registrar will be included in the email with the completed form.

NOTE: The CNN President has 24-48 hours to complete the above three steps. (provided form is correct and player is registered)

TIP: Send the completed form in PDF format as opposed to a picture of the form. The PDF can be signed and returned easily on an electronic device whereas the picture needs to be printed, signed and scanned, this may cause additional delays.

There will be an explanation sheet included in the email with the completed form. This sheet outlines your responsibilities in informing CNN throughout the try-out process. There is also information in the CNN Policies and Procedures.

- You will need the signed Try Out Form with you when you register with the Fort Saskatchewan AAA program.

### AA

If you are pursuing AA hockey and reside within the boundaries of CNN Minor Hockey, you **MUST** try out for the Sturgeon (Morinville) AA team.

- The first thing you need to do is register with CNN Minor Hockey. No AA try out forms will be signed without the player being registered.
- Then complete the 2019-20 AA Try Out Form (posted on the CNN website). Incomplete forms will not be signed.
- Send the completed 2019-20 AA Try Out Form to the CNN President at [president@cnnspurs.com](mailto:president@cnnspurs.com). The President will:
  - Review the form to ensure that it is properly completed
  - Confirm the players registration with CNN for the 2019-20 season

## CNN SPURS MINOR HOCKEY

- Sign the form and send it back to the email address that the form was received from. The CNN registrar will be included in the email with the completed form.

NOTE: The CNN President has 24-48 hours to complete the above three steps. (provided form is correct and player is registered)

### PLAYER MOVEMENT (FEMALE HOCKEY PROGRAMS)

Player Movement forms are generally used at this time of year for female players wishing to play in female programs. Female players from CNN boundaries are generally required to go to the Fort Saskatchewan female program.

- You do not need to register with CNN prior to pursuing female hockey programs.
- Complete the 2019-20 Player Movement Form (posted on the CNN website). Incomplete forms will not be signed.
- Send the completed 2019-20 Player Movement Form to the CNN President at [president@cnnspurs.com](mailto:president@cnnspurs.com). The President will:
  - Review the form to ensure that it is properly completed
  - Sign the form and send it back to the email address that the form was received from. The CNN registrar will be included in the email with the completed form.

NOTE: The CNN President has 24-48 hours to complete the above two steps. (provided form is correct and player is registered)

TIP: Send the completed form in PDF format as opposed to a picture of the form. The PDF can be signed and returned easily on an electronic device whereas the picture needs to be printed, signed and scanned, this may cause additional delays.

- You will need the signed Player Movement Form with you when you register with the Fort Saskatchewan Fury female program.
