Position Summary:

- The Player Development Director is designed to develop support programs and structures to develop quality athletes within CMHA. Ensure all players have no barriers to their progression other than their own ability and drive. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Player Development Director shall:

Specific Responsibilities would include, but not be limited to:

Attendance at all Board meetings

- Schedule of Board meetings will be sent out for the year to all directors
- Devise and deliver annual player education programs on and off ice of CMHA, Etc.
- Define, implement and revise clear goals and objectives for annual player development.
- Liaise with Hockey Alberta and neighboring associations regarding player development opportunities.
- Organize facilities, equipment and personnel to deliver courses effectively.
- Complete necessary financial purchase orders for all purchases relating to player development.
- Complete necessary paperwork relating to CMHA player development processes.
- Return all database information to CMHA if applicable.
- Partner with the Coach Director to help devise and deliver annual programs of workshops and seminars covering all relevant areas of coaching at foundation to performance levels.
- Develop differential programs aimed at the base of the player development process through to more targeted programs for those players higher up the process and at various skill levels.
- Maintain a record of players attending CMHA events.
- Develop the appropriate resources to meet the needs of player development for coaches.
- Perform such other duties as the President may direct.
