## Blue Mountain Batting Cage Safety Plan

Winter training and Clinics

- Only registered CLL coaches and players are permitted to use the batting cage.
- Parents are not permitted in the cage at any time.
- No outside organizations or peoples are to use the cage or any of its equipment. No exceptions.
- Maximum capacity for group training sessions or clinics is two (2) coaches and six (6) players at one time. No exceptions.
- Board members can schedule personal use of the cage for there son or daughter and one other registered player.
- All players and coaches are required to **wear masks** on entry to cage and masks must be used **at** all times by players and coaches.
- Masks will not be provided by CLL for player or coach use.
- All Blue Mountain Cage use is to be scheduled.
- Schedule to be maintained and approved by CLL Vice-President 13+.
  - Absolutely no drop in's allowed.
  - Scheduled time slots will allow for time between sessions for cage and equipment cleaning and to prevent crowding.
  - Cage use will be scheduled in one-hour time slots
  - Players are to exit the cage 15 minutes before the session is over to allow coaches to clean and sanitize. No exceptions.
  - Coaches are responsible for sanitizing balls and equipment after use.
- Players are to be screened, sanitized and attendance taken at entry to cage.
- The attendance register is to be filled out at each session
- Players are to use their own bats, helmets and gloves.
  - CLL will not provide any bats unless special arrangement is made with the coach and approved by VP 13+.
- Each division will use their own dedicated cage balls. These balls will be marked and specific to each Division to ensure compliance with ViaSport and Baseball BC Cohort rules.
- Equipment like batting tees and fitness equipment will be kept in a "Marked sanitized" area.
  - Any time equipment is used it is to be sanitized and returned to the sanitized zone for the following groups.
- In the event of a possible covid exposure the board member running the clinic is responsible for:
  - Contacting all players that were exposed
  - Cleaning the cage of all possible contact surfaces
