

## **East Hants Nationals Baseball Program**

5U (\$65 + \$60(50/50 tickets)

5U TBall Players must turn 4 or 5 years old within this calendar year

6U (\$65 + \$60 50/50 tickets)

6U Rally Cap Players must turn 6 within this calendar year

9U (\$245 + \$60 50/50 tickets)

9U Players must turn 7, 8 or 9 years old within this calendar year

11U (\$245 + \$60 50/50 tickets)

11U Players must turn 10 or 11 years old within this calendar year

12U Girls (\$265 + \$60 50/50 tickets)

12U Players must turn 10, 11 or 12 years old within this calendar year

13U (\$265 + \$60 50/50 tickets)

13U Players must turn 12 or 13 years old within this calendar year

14U Girls (\$305 + \$60 50/50 tickets)

14U Players must turn 13 or 14 years old within this calendar year

15U (\$305 + \$60 50/50 tickets)

15U Players must turn 14 or 15 years old within this calendar year

18U (\$325 + \$60 50/50 tickets)

18U Players must turn 16, 17 or 18 years old within this calendar year

## **SPRING TRAINING - 9U and UP**

This program runs for 6 weeks at the East Hants Sportsplex in Lantz, usually beginning in early April. The cost is \$60 and is an optional program open to all players to register.

It's designed to get players on the field, practicing and developing their baseball skills. Spring Training is run by CMBA's East Hants Nationals Coaches, Assistant Coaches and parent volunteers.

## **Rep Team Tryouts/Evaluations – 11U and UP**

Players interested in playing on a Travel Baseball Team (AA) are welcome and encouraged to try out for one. These evaluations are held at the East Hants Sportsplex the week after Spring Training ends.

## **9U Evaluations and Team Assigning**

All 9U players will gather on the small field at the George P. Horne Memorial Fields at the Enfield Legion sometime late in May or early June. Players will go through three or four basic baseball skill stations while the 9U Coaches, Assistant Coaches and Parent volunteers help out. After the session the 9U coaches will assign teams so they are balanced between skill and age.

### **\*\*\* 50/50 tickets\*\*\* Draw Date: Early August**

- Tickets cost \$60 and must be paid at time of registration.
- ALL players receive thirty 50/50 tickets at their first night of baseball.
- This cost is added to your registration fee.

You can sell the tickets to your friends, neighbors, family etc. They are \$2 each. If you sell them all, you will get your \$60 back to keep OR you can put your name on all of them and enter them all into the draw. This will increase your chances of winning the 50/50 draw. The jackpot is typically around \$6000. It's totally up to you how you handle your tickets.

The player who sells the winning ticket will receive his/her baseball registration FREE for the following year. There is no cash value attached to the Free Registration, if it cannot be used, it can be transferred to another player to be used in this current season.
