LOCATIONS

George P. Horne Memorial Fields are located in Enfield behind the Enfield Legion. Lions Club Field is also in Enfield on the Old Enfield Rd. We operate a 3rd field located at the Milford Recreation Centre in Milford.

George P. Horne Memorial Fields

- There are 2 washrooms located at this location. They are open when there are practices, games and tournaments happening.
- Our canteen is open when there are games, practices and tournaments happening. We have a 'Buy 5 Get 1 Free' Slushie program along with lots of game time snacks and treats. We take CASH/DEBIT at the canteen.

Milford Recreation Centre

- There are washrooms located in the main building.

IMPORTANT NOTES - PLEASE READ

- Players will not receive their uniforms and will not be allowed on the field until they have registered and paid.
- T-Ball and Rally Cap players will receive a Nationals T-Shirt and hat on their first night.
- 9U -18U players will receive a Nationals hat, Jersey, white baseball pants and their 50/50 tickets on their first night.

SPRING TRAINING - 9U and UP

This program is held at the East Hants Sportsplex in Lantz and is an optional program open to all players to register. It's designed to get players on the field, practicing and developing their baseball skills before the season starts. Spring Training is run by CMBA's East Hants Nationals Coaches, Assistant Coaches and parent volunteers. The Spring Training schedule will be e-mailed to those players who register for it and it will be posted on CMBA's FB page as well.

9U Evaluations and Team Assigning

All 9U players will gather on the small field at the George P. Horne Memorial Fields at the Enfield Legion sometime late in May or early June. Players will go through three or four basic baseball skill stations while the 9U Coaches and Assistant Coaches assess

the entire group. After the sessions, the 9U coaches will assign teams so they are balanced between skill and age.

11U, 12U Girls, 13U, 14U Girls, 15U Evaluations

Rep Team Evaluations will take place after Spring Training is complete. Emails will be sent out to families with all the information regarding these Try Outs. There is no fee to try out.

18U Evaluations

18U Rep Team tryouts are for our more serious East Hants Nationals players who want to play on a REP/Travel team. Emails will be sent out to the 18U families with all the information regarding these Try Outs. The \$100 Try Out fee is non-refundable.

5U/6U Rally Cap

This group gets on the field either the last week of June or the 1st week of July. The schedule will depend on parent volunteer availability as this program is lead by parents. More info will be e-mailed to this group as we get closer to June.

JERSEYS (this does not apply to 5U/6U Rally Cap)

EH Nationals jerseys must be returned to coaches at the end of the season.

If a players' jersey is not returned at the end of the 2025 season, CMBA will charge your RAMP account \$100. Payment must be received before the end of September 2025 or your player will not be allowed to play the 2026 Baseball season with CMBA.

3rd Player Discount

50% off registration for 3rd (or more) player/sibling in the same family.

LATE FEES/REFUNDS

A \$30 late fee will be applied to registrations that come in after March 14, 2025

Full refunds are available, however, after June 1, 2025, \$30 of your registration fee is non-refundable.

FUNDRAISING

***** 50/50 tickets*** Draw Date: Early August**

- Tickets cost \$60 and must be paid at time of registration.
- ALL players receive thirty 50/50 tickets at their first night of baseball.
- This cost is added to your registration fee.

How it works:

You can put your name on all your tickets and enter them into the draw. This will increase your chances of winning the 50/50 OR you can sell the tickets and get your \$60 back as you have already paid CMBA for them. They are \$2 each. It's totally up to you how you handle your tickets.

The player who sells the winning ticket will receive his/her baseball registration FREE for the following year. There is no cash value attached to the Free Registration, if it

cannot be used, it can be transferred to another player to be used in the following season.
