## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION – PLEASE READ**

- **Team formation is strictly dependant on having a minimum number of registered players and sufficient qualified volunteer coaches. Corridor Minor Baseball reserves the right to cancel a team if minimum roster sizes are not met or if volunteer roles remain unfilled. In the event of cancellation due to these factors, a full refund will be issued.**
- It is MANDATORY to enter your player(s) correct year of birth.
- Players WILL NOT receive their uniforms and WILL NOT be allowed on the field until they have registered and paid.
- 9U -18U players will receive a Nationals hat, Jersey and white baseball pants.

## **SPRING TRAINING (except Rally Cap, 7U T-Ball and Challenger)**

- 2026 Fee: \$115
- Optional program although we do encourage all players to register.
- Designed to get players on the field; practicing and developing their baseball skills before the season starts.
- Spring Training is run by CMBA's East Hants Nationals Coaches, Assistant Coaches and parent volunteers.
- Location: East Hants Sportsplex

## **RALLY CAP 5U**

- This program is best suited for beginner players who turn 4 or 5 in 2026. (Born in 2021-2022).
- This program is volunteer parent lead and focuses on fun; running the bases, batting off a tee and catching.
- Teams meet one afternoon/evening a week for an hour, beginning the 1st week of July and runs for 8 weeks.
- After your player is assigned to his/her group (mid June) you will receive an e-mail with details on day and time.
- All Rally Cap players will receive a BNS hat and a Nationals t-shirt that they get to keep.
- Ensure you player wears comfortable running shoes, brings a glove and lots of water!
- If players have batting helmets and bats, they can bring those as well.
- TRAINING SESSION: a week or two before the official start of RALLY CAP we will hold a fun training session with a BNS Rep at the Lion's Den ballfield in Enfield. Details on this will be e-mailed to all RALLY Cap families a week or two before it happens.

## **T-BALL 7U**

- This program will be best suited for players who have finished Rally Cap and new players who will turn 6 and 7 in 2026 (Birth years; 2019 and 2020).
- This program is designed to bridge the gap between 3<sup>rd</sup> year Rally Cap players and 9U.
- This program will continue to focus on the basics of running, hitting, batting and catching.
- Ensure you player wears comfortable running shoes, brings a glove and lots of water.
- If players have batting helmets and bats, they can bring those as well.
- After your player is assigned to his/her group (mid June) you will receive an e-mail with details on day and time.
- All T-Ballers will receive a BNS hat and a Nationals t-shirt that they get to keep.

## **7U T-BALL and 9U**

- We have added a 7U T-Ball program this year which is for players who turn 6 or beginner players who turn 7 in 2026 (Birth years; 2019 and 2020). This program is designed to bridge the gap between Rally Cap and 9U. It will give players more opportunities to continue to focus on the basics of running, hitting, catching and throwing. Players with a birthyear of 2019 will have the option to choose 7U T-Ball or 9U. We recommend registering for 7U Tee Ball if your player is turning 7 this year and is still developing the basic skills. If your player is turning 7 this year and can hit pitched balls, throw, and catch, then we recommend registering for our 9U program.

## **9U EVALUATIONS**

- Sat. May 9, 4-5:30pm
- All 9U players are to attend this Evaluation Session.
- Players will go through 4-5 basic skill stations while our 9U Coaches/Assistant Coaches assesses the entire group.
- After the sessions, the 9U coaches will assign teams so they are balanced between skill and age.
- The Dome rental fee of \$20 is built into the 9U package.

## **9U Major League (NEW TO CMBA)**

CMBA recently applied for inclusion into the Dartmouth Diamond Dawgs 9U Major League program, and we are hoping to participate in this league. What is it?

- Recreational baseball for players who will be aged 8 to 9 in 2026, however, this program is designed for the advancing players within the age group.
- Players selected for this cohort will be determined after the May 9<sup>th</sup> balancing session.
- The concept of "real games" is introduced at the onset of the season.
- Modifications should be expected around pitching. There is an emphasis placed on development and players will rotate through all positions throughout the season.
- 9U Major teams play games in a DDMBA Rec League (Dartmouth, Halifax, Bedford, Eastern Passage & Enfield) with regular weekly practice times scheduled each week.

## **COMPETITIVE (REP) TRYOUTS (11U, 13U, 15U, 18U)**

- To sign up for Rep Team Tryouts, please register under the appropriate Competitive Package.
- Tryout Dates for the 2026 season are: April 2 and April 4
- Location: East Hants Sportsplex
- Times: TBD (the schedule will be e-mailed to all players registered for a Competitive Team)
- Try out fees are built into the Competitive Package and is NON - REFUNDABLE (\$20). The Try Out fee covers the cost of the Dome rental.
- The Fee difference between Competitive and House is \$65. If you register your player for a Competitive Team (Try Outs) but end up returning to our house program – you will receive a refund for the difference between the appropriate house and competitive registration fee amounts (excluding the NON-REFUNDABLE tryout fee). The refund is \$45.
- Competitive Team REP Fees covers BNS Rep Team Registration and Provincial Registration Costs.

## **GIRLS**

12U – Birth Year 2014, 2015, 2016

14U – Birth Year 2012, 2013

- Girls can play as an over-ager. For example if she is 12 in 2026 – she can play 11U; 15 – she can play 14U, etc.
- Baseball for girls who will be age 10, 11 or 12 or 13 or 14 in 2026. 12U and 14U teams compete in the Baseball Nova Scotia Bluenose League and generally participate in several tournaments during the baseball season.
