



2021 Registration Information

We are excited to welcome our players back to the box. This year will be a little different and we are keeping our players safety at the top of the list.

As of February 10, 2021 CVLA is offering box lacrosse in the midst of Covid 19 Phase 2 restrictions. What that means is there will be no league play on the island. Due to there being no league play, CVLA has adjusted their fees for the 2021 playing season. These fees reflect the cost of not needing to pay referees for games.

Phase 3 Covid 19 Additional Fees:

Should the Provincial Health Officer raise the restrictions and allow for Phase 3 play, CVLA will require all players registered to pay an additional \$40 to cover referee fees. If a player does not feel safe playing league play, they are able to withdraw from the program. Refunds will be applied as outlined in the Refund Policy.

When registering more than one child online please ensure you select the "add another player" button on the right side of the screen. All discounts will be added at the end.

New Players must bring:

1. a copy of birth certificate
2. Care card.

Your registration will not be complete until this is provided as it is now mandatory by BCLA.

Late fees of \$15.00 will be added to the regular registration fees on the following dates:

OTHER FEES AND DEPOSITS

- Sibling discount is \$25 (Regular price for oldest child, \$25 off for each additional child).
 - Jersey deposit -Should Phase 3 play go ahead a \$100.00 (post dated cheque to be given to Team Manager before jersey is handed out). You may receive two jerseys, if that happens a \$200 deposit is required. In Phase 2 each player will be given a pinnie. There will be a \$50 Pinnie deposit (post dated cheque to be given to Team Manager within a week of the pinnie being handed out)

Referral Program

CVLA offers a Referral Program to all our returning players. If you refer a new player or players to CVLA Lacrosse and that player(s) plays the entire season than you will be refunded \$25.00 per referral at the end of the season. ASSESSMENTS

Due to Covid 19 CVLA and the VIMLC has decided to flatten teams to keep the ability to play in cohorts easier. There are no A teams in CVLA this season. They are all house teams and balanced. These assessments will be of no charge. DO NOT CHECK the Tryout Box when you sign up. Please go to Cowichan Thunder Lacrosse website for assessment dates and information.

If you register after assessments are complete in your division, you will not be assessed but will be placed on a team that requires players.

WAIT LISTS:

The CVLA executive may implement a wait list once each division has the team maximum of 16 players. The executive will do everything possible to make sure every player wanting to play has the opportunity to do so.

We encourage all players to register early to assist with accurate registration numbers for teams and to avoid being wait-listed.
