# Annual General Meeting

The current board has indicated they are all running for their positions again.

## **2026 CVMHA AGM - ELECTION OF OFFICERS**

Job descriptions as they currently appear in Bylaws. Details descriptions can be found in policies.

### **Role of the President**

6.1 The president is the chair of the Board and is responsible for supervising the other directors in the execution of their duties.

### **Role of the Vice President**

6.2 The first vice-president is the vice-chair of the Board and is responsible for carrying out the duties of the president if the president is unable to act. They are responsible for complaints and investigations and reporting all findings in writing to the President.

### **Role of the Managing Directors (Competitive & Level III)**

6.4 The Competitive Director, Female, U21 Director, U15/U18 Director, U11/U13 Director, U6-U9 Director are responsible for supervision of the head coaches, assistant coaches, managers, and business of the division they represent to ensure that the development programs are implemented and delivered to the players within their division.

### **Role of the Treasurer**

6.5 The treasurer is responsible to ensure the financial duties of the Appointed Director of Hockey Administration are complete. They shall present monthly financials to the board.

### **Role of the Equipment Manager**

6.6 The equipment manager is responsible for doing or making the necessary arrangements for maintaining the equipment of the Society and establishing and monitoring the equipment policies of the Society.
