This includes the following: taking a positive approach to player mistakes, demonstrating respect for referees regardless of the call, respect for the competition, and respect for each player in front of fans, teammates, and opposing players. Coaches will teach players to be a class act, win or lose

Responsibilities:

- Serve as the official spokesperson on behalf of the team
- Coordinate the delegation of responsibilities to the assistant coach and manager
- Plan on and off-ice activities in consultation with the assistant coach
- Design the practice plans in consultation with the assistant coach
- Coach the team in all games and practices
- Establish rules for the team and oversee the supervision of the players
