Position Title: Team Manager

Overview: The primary role of a Team Manager is to support the Head Coach in the administrative aspects of the team. This may include maintaining game sheets, data entry, organizing team volunteers, registering for tournaments, creating a team budget, collecting team fees etc. By taking on the operational aspects of the team, the manager enables the coach to focus on player development and onice instruction to provide the players with a rewarding hockey experience.

Responsibilities:

- Encourage and recruit team parents for positions required during the season i.e., Treasurer, fundraising, home tournaments, time clock/game sheets etc.
- Prepare parents' contact/responsibilities list and hand out to all parents
- Pass along schedule for league games, tournaments attending, practices, etc., to all parents
- Prepare game sheets APP prior to all home league, exhibition, and playoff/playdown games
- Arrange team volunteers for completion of game sheets and running of time clock for all home games
