8) New Business/Questions from Membership

- -Asked if we considered the idea of a 'C' team for U13 house as some kids in house who didn't make the rep teams did not feel challenged
 - * Is something board has thought about and will be discussed, not sure the outcome but will discuss it
- A few members expressed concern over not having a tiering tournament for EK teams last year. This led into a discussion about house team evaluations/team section being done differently to ensure more even teams.
 - * It was a decision by the EK League to not tier last year, it is not up to CMHA.
 - * Each year we try out best with team selection, always looking at ways to improve and refine the process
 - * Some variables out of CMHA control one is late registration kids being added to teams after evals with no understanding of their skill etc
 - * Varying level of skill, commitment etc in house. Some kids will develop faster and we have no way to predict this
 - *Try to accommodate requests for players to stay on teams together to assist parents with carpooling etc.
- -Asked if U11 was planning an all-girls team like U9 last year and if it will be mandatory
 *If numbers allow it will be considered but playing only on the all-girls team
 would not be mandatory
- -Asked if information from coaches surveys will be made available to coaches *Rep coaches were given theirs as there are less coaches to circulate to

*Information used to see trends with coaches and kept on file for reference

-Graham Waugh thanked CMHA for assistance in sending two officials to a camp this summer. Of 108 officials, 15 responded and the 2 selected were Wyatt Daignault and Reid Geddes
