#### c. Registration

- Discussed need to increase fees a bit a little each year instead of all at once to cover increasing ice costs

Motion by Giacomo to increase registration by \$20 per player, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Pam Pinch Board voted and motion carried.

- -Discussed dates for registration to ensure accounts are inline for optimal gaming grants Motion to open registration May 1<sup>st</sup> with a May 31<sup>st</sup> rep deadline Board voted and motion carried.
  - -Late rep registrations will be discussed case by case and will be required to pay a \$250 late fee in addition to the \$120 try out fee
  - -Donation box for KidSport successfully added to the registration options

#### 5) New Business

#### a. Underage AP Process

- -Typical process is Avs (or top team in that age group) calls up from the Bucks of the same age group and then the Bucks call up from rec of the same age group etc.
- -In rare cases, as seen this past season, players can be deemed skilled enough to be an underage AP (ie U11-u13)
- -Player was U11 A and was AP'd directly to U13 Avs optics do not look great when this happens
- -Discussed that in these cases there should be a policy in place to require board discussion, so we make sure we are keeping the development of all players as the priority

Motion by Aaron Byng-Hall to require board approval before an undeage player can be added to an AP list .

Second motion by Aaron Byng-Hall for that team to be allowed to call that player up for 3 games and 5 practices- anything above this requires approval from the executive board each time.
