



Covid Safety Disciplinary Guidelines

Updated November 4th 2021

The CMHA board members met and discussed some standardized disciplinary measures for anyone found to be breaching our Covid Policy or the Provincial Health Orders (PHO's) as well as anyone found to be harrasing our volunteers.

In Breach of PHO's or our Covid Safety Plans- 1st Offence

If a player is found to be in breach of the PHO's or our Covid Safety Plan (ie at ice times while on isolation etc.) Or If a parent/spectator is found to be in breach of the PHO's or our Covid Safety Plan (ie entering the rink without showing their vaccine passport etc)

- The player may be suspended from participating in a minimum of **3** CMHA ice sessions or 14 days, whichever is greater. The parents of this player may also be suspended from attending/participating in any CMHA events for a minimum of 14 days.

In Breach of PHO's or our Covid Safety Plans- 2nd Offence

- Will be dealt with on a case by case basis by our disciplinary committee but may result in a suspension for the remainder of the season.

Harrassment of CMHA Volunteer Including but not Limited to Covid Passport Checkers- 1st Offence

- Any individual found to be harrasing CMHA volunteers may be suspended from attending any CMHA events for a minimum of 14 DAYS

Harrassment of CMHA Volunteer Including but not Limited to Covid Passport Checkers- 2nd Offence

- Will be dealt with on a case by case basis by our disciplinary committee but may result in a suspension for the remainder of the season.
