- 5) New Business
  - a. U13 SCAHL vs OMAHA
    - OMAHA did not accept our U13 Bucks, and unfortunately didn't tell us for over a month after their decision was made.
    - We went to Lee Wilm and the EK to help resolve this issue as it was not in line with what had previously been discussed and the vision of EK hockey
    - Sherri reached out to Aaron after Lee contacted appropriate people and asked us for a neutral site and what tier we were wanting to play at
    - We said no to neutral site and said that we would be attending the tiering tournament to help determine what tier.
    - OMAHA is planning a zoom meeting with all the U13 teams and Cranbrook on Thursday July 28<sup>th</sup>
    - In the meantime, we have approached SCAHL to see if they would accept our U13 team back to the SCAHL.
    - Waiting for answers from SCAHL
    - We will reconsider our future path for U15 and U18
    - We may have to change tryout dates now if U13 is going to SCAHL, as well as for the U18 level due to them having to attend the tiering tournament in OMAHA

  - b. Clark/Pel Request
    - Clark/Pel came back to us with a proposal to counter our declining of them back in the rink.
    - We have agreed that we will revisit their in rink suspension at our December meeting (in the meantime they are still not allowed in the rink), they are allowed to have appropriate and necessary contact with team staff from the beginning of the season, any and all issues they have with Team or team staff or parents/children are to go to Todd Leffler our president to be dealt with, they will still have a lifetime probation with CMHA.
