



Out of Area Policy

Preamble

A Clarence-Rockland resident is a player whose principal residence is within the jurisdiction of CRRA. CRRA is considered the player's home association.

Any player who played on any CRRA team in the just completed season on a release is defined as an in association player. CRRA is considered the player's current association.

An out of area player is a player whose principal place of residence is outside the geographical jurisdiction of CRRA.

Procedure

Tryouts at the competitive level are open to all players from all associations.

The maximum number of out of area players per team will be three (this number excludes goaltenders).

Any exception will require approval by the Executive.

An out of area player* must be ranked in the top half of all skaters by the Association appointed evaluators to be considered for a position on a team.

Any exception will require approval by the Executive.

*ORA/ERRA has stated that for the purpose of tryouts, associations will treat all players from their teams in the just completed season as in-association, regardless of the player's actual status. This is based on the "current association" rule. Please refer to section 9.1.9 of ORA's Membership Services Operating Manual for the complete policy.
