## CUSA Membership January 6, 2022 COVID19 Update

As of today (Jan 6<sup>th</sup>) our programs continue to operate as scheduled with consideration to our leagues needs and overall health and safety.

We are currently receiving several calls regarding status of games when teams are having players test positive or have been exposed. We continue to work with each team on a case-by-case basis. In doing this we will ask that the team has undertaken a couple of steps prior to requesting a game postponement; are there sufficient registered players available for the match &/or have you contacted potential call ups? If after consideration of these options, you do not have sufficient players to field a team reach out to the CUSA Office by either email or phone.

We will continue to work with teams to apply best efforts to have these matches rescheduled. We are monitoring the impact on the number of games that this is having on the various leagues. We will continue to work with each of you to keep the games safe, to accomplish this we do require your support with the notifications and reschedules.

Should AHS and ASA change any of the guidelines for adult sport delivery we will promptly share the information with you. As this situation continues to evolve and give challenges to everyone, we appreciate your support and cooperation.

Reminder of the continuing guidelines:

Game venues are requesting **all teams** limit spectators to no more than 1 spectator per player. All venues have capacity limits that are required to be enforced.

- Current restrictions include no external food or beverages being brought into the facility.
- Masks to be worn when not on the playing surface.
- Dressing rooms will be available 15 minutes before and after games / practices

All other measures are still in place

 Proof of vaccination, a negative test result or a medical exemption, along with government issued ID is required for all participant over 12 years of age.

Since the arrival of the pandemic, we have continued to communicate with our membership and strive to provide an opportunity to have a safe return to the game.
