Letter from the President

Dear friends of Calgary United Soccer Association,

As we continue our recovery from the Covid-19 pandemic, we began our return to the sport we all love. We were able to welcome players, coaches, referees and all our stakeholders back to the pitch safely. Together we were able to return to a sense of normalcy in our soccer community.

With the unique times we were facing, CUSA was able to pivot and provide a unique solution for Outdoor 2021 to maximize participation and ensure flexibility to our members. The interest to get back out on the pitch was very strong with teams able to register for six- or twelve-week programs. This creative offering allowed us to have 169 teams participating in our programs.

For the Indoor 2021-22 season, CUSA was able to finally offer normal programming to its members. We had 191 teams participating throughout the programs. The continued shift of more and more teams to non-boarded soccer was noticeable as we reached capacity for non-boarded field times. Our members and stakeholders worked together to ensure a safe and successful season and because of this co-operation, we were able to complete the season with minimal number of cancellations. Our members were very understanding of the short notice cancellations, once again showing the strong bond in our community. The success of the season was celebrated with the return of the Indoor Nations Cup tournament. It was amazing to see the community come together and celebrate the beautiful game. Spectators showed up en masse to support their teams but more importantly to celebrate the return of normalcy for our soccer community. Their action on the pitch matched the enthusiasm of the fans. A year ago, it did not seem possible to host this type of event, but we are all able to pull together and make it happen.

The past year also saw another first for our soccer community. The strength of our futsal program was on display for the whole country as Callies FC went on to represent Alberta at the 2022 Futsal Canadian Championship. Callies FC put in a very strong effort and their hard work was rewarded with them winning the bronze medal. This is a very significant event and something we all can be proud of as Callies FC are the first team outside Ontario and Quebec to win a medal at the Futsal Canadian Championship. Our strength and commitment to futsal has been noticed as we are currently working with Sport Tourism Calgary to secure a suitable venue to host the 2023 Futsal Canadian Championship. It will be the first time this championship has been held in another province besides Ontario and Quebec.

Off the pitch, we worked hard and diligently to have our new fieldhouse completed at our Broadview Field. The building entered near completion after a very long road that began in 2019 and had many bumps and curves. The fieldhouse will match what has been the premier grass



pitch in amateur soccer for many years. The new fieldhouse will be a beacon for the whole soccer community to come together and promote the game. We, just as you should be proud of this unmatched fieldhouse and pitch that will set a new standard for all.

CUSA continues to lead the way in Equity, Diversity, Inclusion, and Indigeneity (EDII) of which I am extremely proud as should all our members. Even though we are leaders in this area in our sport, we do realize we still have a long road ahead of us. The work in EDII is never ending. It is work that we need to continue all the time and never get complacent with. CUSA is very proud of the diversity throughout our organization and look forward to playing a leadership role to make our sport and our community more inclusive and safer for all.

Together, we will continue to use soccer to build a stronger community and raise awareness of our association and the beautiful game. We can only achieve this with all of us working in harmony.

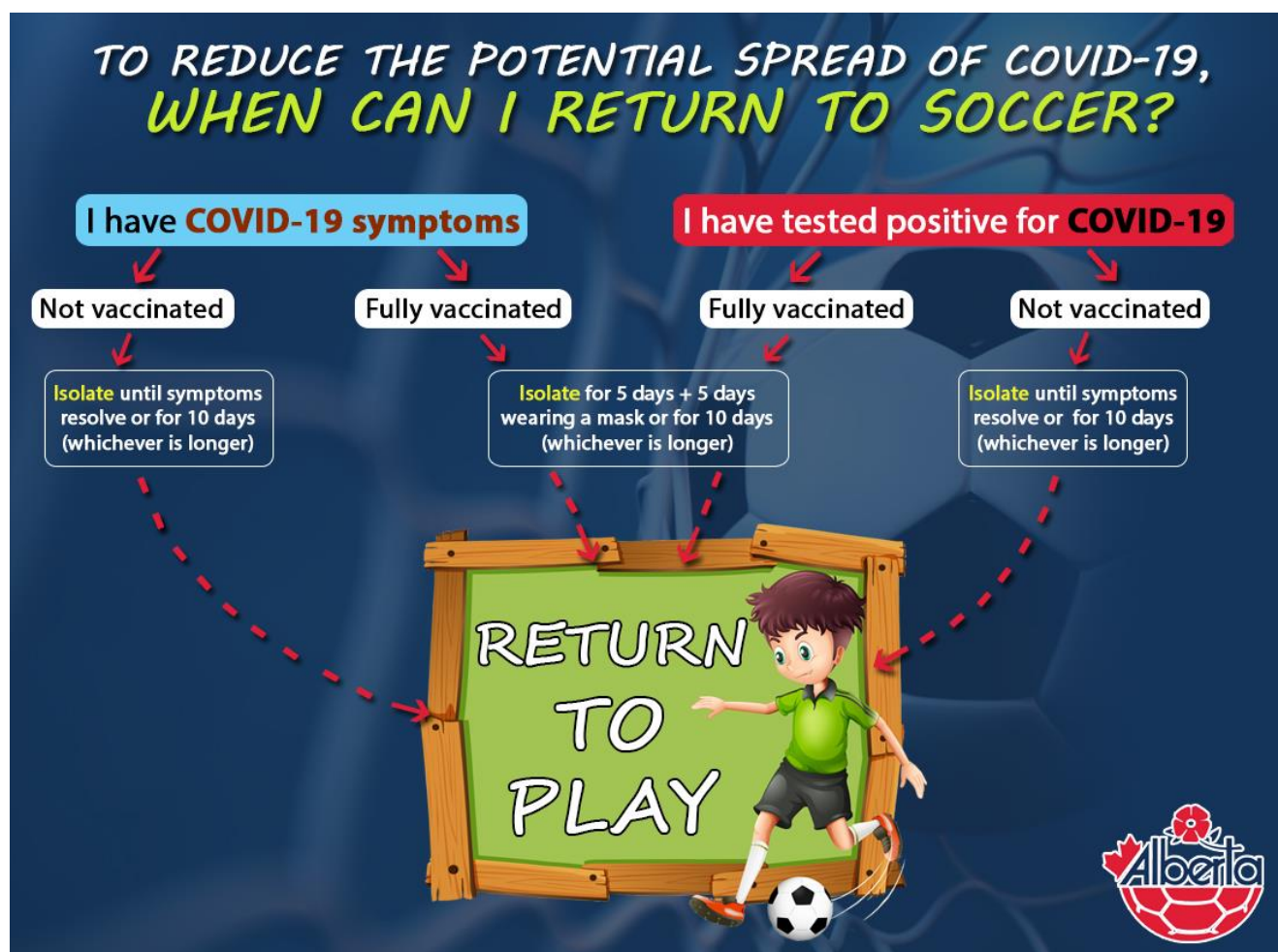

Executive Summary

Soccer throughout 2021 and into 2022 continued to look different. It is our commitment to our league membership to ensure that we are here to support them as sport is ready to safely return. Through the dedication of an amazing team, strong financial oversight, an unwavering focus on the league we're designed to support we are set up to be ready to support our membership as our community brings sport back to life. We have a great appreciation for the role we are fortunate to play in our community.

2022 Accomplishments

Teams and coaches became creative in finding ways to still connect with their players. Training in all aspects of the sport didn't stop! Volunteers, coaches, athletes, officials, and administrators all participated in various online training opportunities.

CUSA Coaches had the opportunity to expand their knowledge and learning through online National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP) workshops and professional development training offered through both Canada Soccer and Alberta Soccer.

League Administration focussed on seeking funding from a diverse range of agencies to ensure that the financial impact of the pandemic could be minimized as much as reasonable possible.

The Broadview Trailer Replacement Project wove its way through the exceeding long list of approvals and revisions. Work will continue throughout 2021 for the construction of the new facility with substantial completion achieved in December. First games on the field and utilizing the facility occurred in May of 2022.



Return to Competition 2021

In July of 2021 Adult Sport was able to resume, with a variety of restrictions in place. CUSA provided the membership the opportunity to return to play through the offerings of 6- and 12-week program modules.

The Guidelines are primarily designed to help member organizations manage their liability and remain compliant with all applicable public health authorities when returning to soccer and related activities. The Guidelines may help member organizations determine which new policies need to be adopted, including social and physical distancing for training, restricting the number of players participating in such training, and restricting game play.



Financials

For the year ended March 31, 2022, the staff and the board worked very hard to ensure the financial health continued during the not so regular year it was. We went out and applied for any government subsidies we were eligible for and received just over \$128,000 in funds.

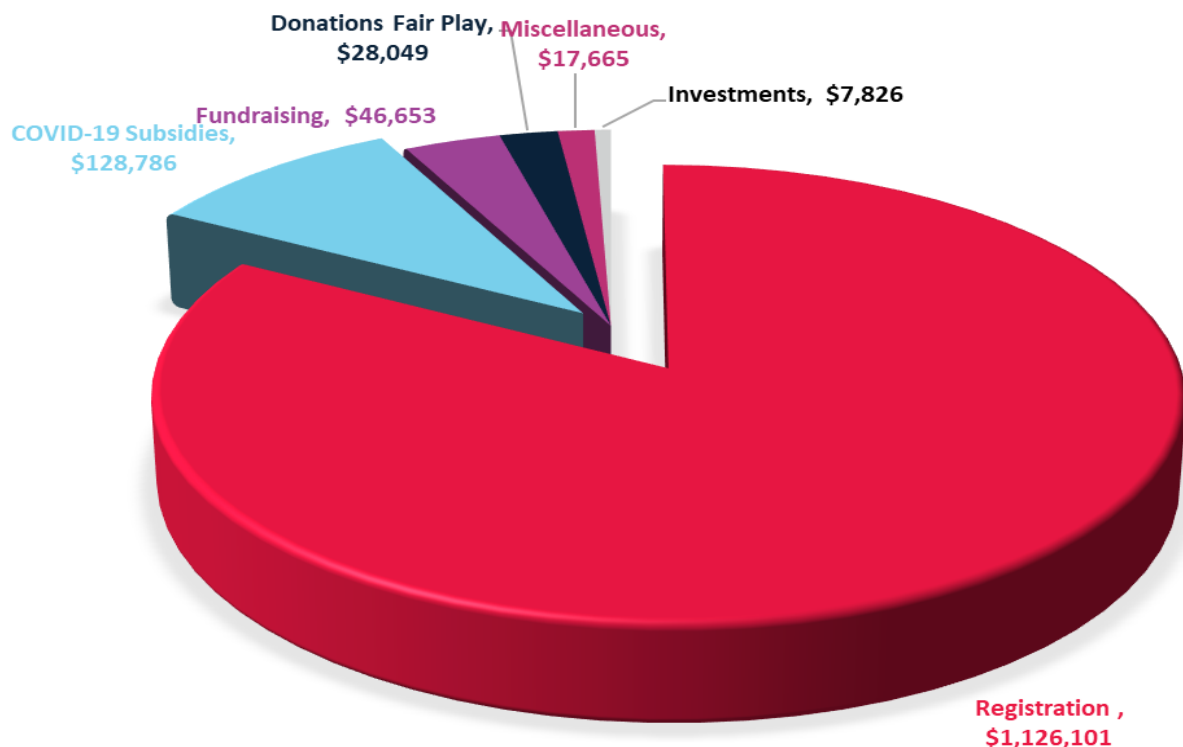
Gaming licences continue to be a part of CUSA's fundraising efforts and help ensure members continue to benefit from proceeds generated. CUSA thanks all those that volunteered at the Casino held over August long weekend and supported our 50 50 raffles during Indoor Nations Cup.

As we returned to the pitch our goal was to keep team fees as low as possible to help and encourage a return to our sport. CUSA also took the decision not to pass on the expense of rescheduled games to our members during these difficult times.

As a result of our due diligence, we were able to generate a small profit of just over \$45,000. At the same time, we were able to increase our cash flow for the year by just over \$355,000 through careful financial management. Once again, the team at CUSA, both staff and the Board has shown our dedication to being fiscal stewards for your association.

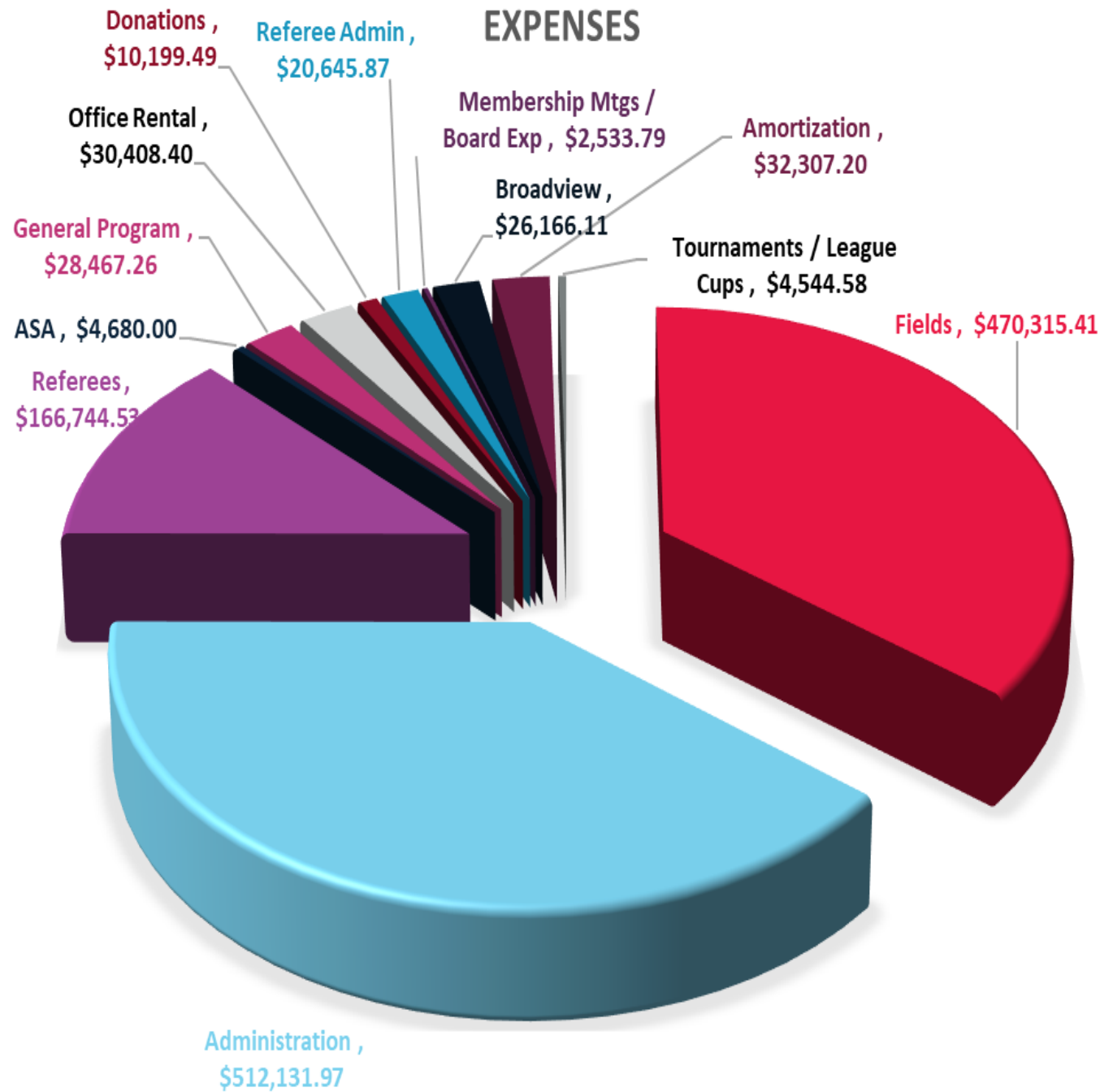
Revenue Sources

Courses

In 2021 we were able to host Entry Level courses and continue to provide training opportunities for those wishing to become an official once the association was able to return to game play. In 2022 there have been 131 new officials who have successfully completed their Entry Level Referee course during this past year.

The finals evening started out with Colombia defeating Scotland to earn bragging rights for the Master's Division.

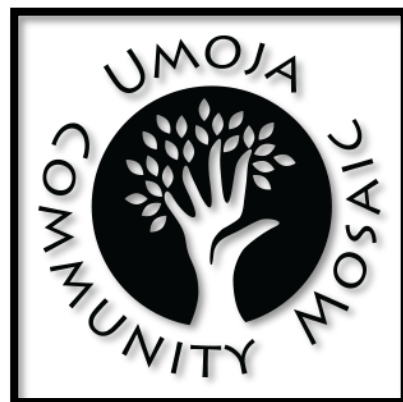
