Frequently Asked Questions

WHO CAN REGISTER WITH CUSA?

All CUSA programs are open to individuals over the age of 16 with the exception of COED programs, which are for ages 18+ only.

Where are Games Played?

- *Outdoor Fields – we use various City of Calgary athletic parks located in all quadrants.*
- *Indoor Boarded Facilities – Calgary Soccer Centre, Genesis Centre.*
- *Indoor 8v8 Facilities – Foothills Field House, Calgary West Soccer Centre.*
- *Futsal Facilities – Ambrose University.*

Can I register as an individual?

No. To register with CUSA you have to know which team you will be on.

I want to play Soccer but I'm new to Calgary and don't know where to start.

This is a good place to start. Review CUSA programs in this document and follow the flow chart for how to register. CUSA will not assign you to a team but we have resources in place to help you find a team that is looking for players.

FAQ

How many teams can I be registered on?

You can be registered on one team per program.

Can I use one player card for all teams?

No. Every player must have a CUSA ID card for each program they are registered in.

FAQ

How much does it cost to register?

It varies. CUSA charges teams as a whole and teams then distribute those costs amongst the players. On average our players pay \$300 for an 18-20 game season. Player fees are paid directly to the team and not to CUSA.

Is there a cost for the player card?

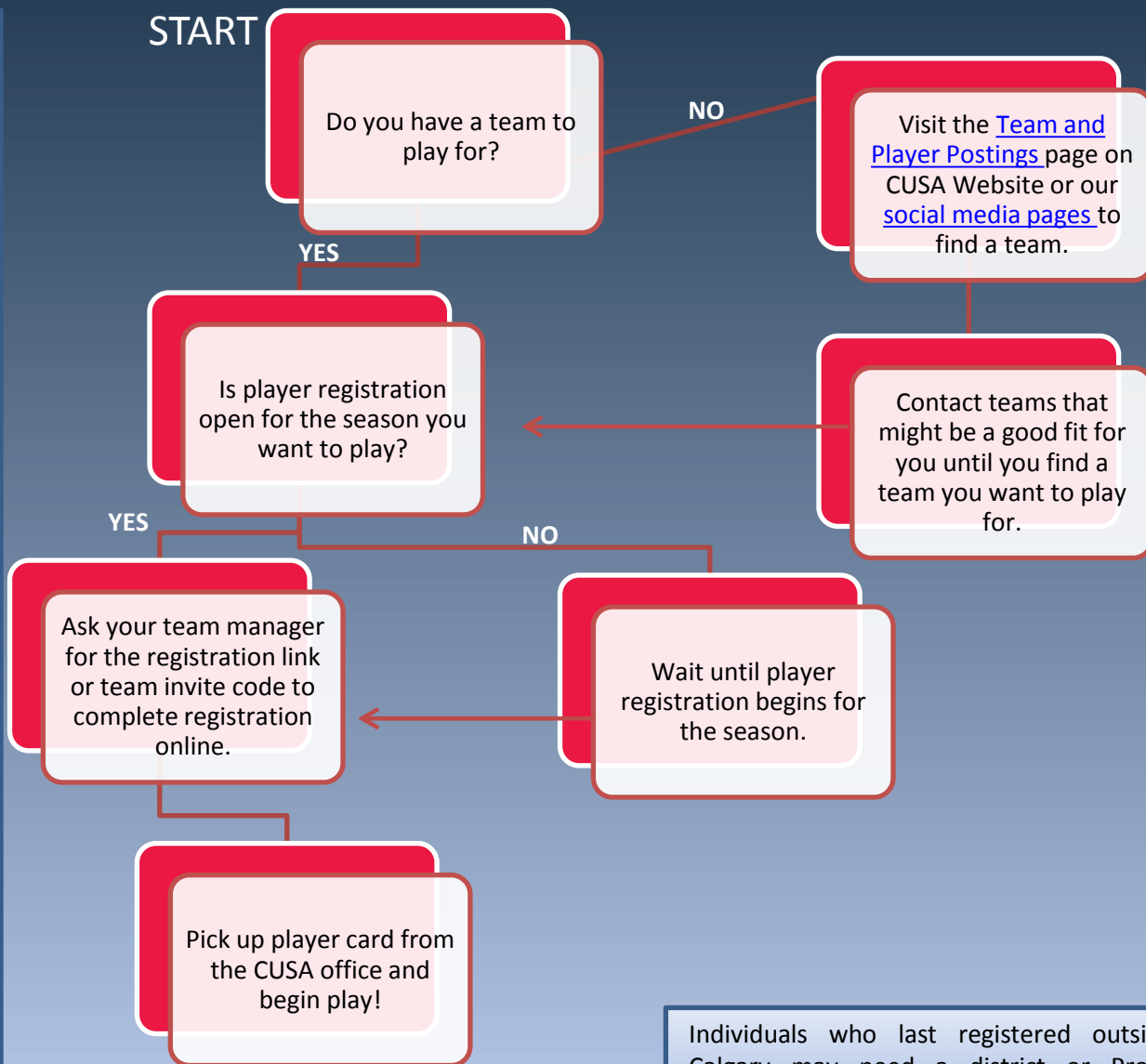
Yes, there is a \$20 fee for the player card that can be paid when picking up the card.

Can I play before picking up the card?

No. the game officials will not allow you play without a valid CUSA ID.
