## Before Registering A Team

- Identify a Coach or Team Manager who will be the main point of contact with the league. Ideally, this person will register the team for the season. The individual who registers a team for the season will have access to the team's financials.
- Ensure your team meets the roster requirements for CUSA. A minimum of 12 players must be registered by the date of your first game and must be maintained throughout the season. The maximum is 25 players on the roster, with a max of 20 at a game.
- Decide if you want to pay for Assistant Referees, or if your team will supply a
  volunteer at each game. To have a league assigned AR, the cost is approx. \$650 for
  18 games. Teams in Provincial Divisions are required to pay for AR's and the cost is
  included in league fees.
- Each team must have 2 sets of numbered jerseys. In the event of a conflict, the home team must change. Pinnies are not allowed in CUSA league play.
- Be prepared to play 7 days a week. Scheduling requests can be made when registering the team. All teams will have both weekend and weekdays games.
- Airdrie, Cochrane and Okotoks all play in the CUSA league. Be prepared to travel, at most, 2 times a season to their home fields. Not all divisions will have a rural team.
- Home Team's must supply two game balls

## After Registering A Team

 Monitor your emails. CUSA will send important league and tournament information as well as fee deadline reminders leading up to the start of the season, and throughout.

- All players must have a valid ID card at each game. The ID card must state the current team or club that the player is registered with.
- Have a team representative attend the Managers Meeting at the start of every season. League schedules are available for the first time at this meeting, and important league and rule updates are provided.
- Every team must send a representative to the Annual General Meeting in June of every year. Adequate notice will be sent to all team officials. This is the only mandatory meeting that membership must attend.
